NOTICE OF OPPOSITION

- 1. Applicant Flash Sales, Inc. ("Applicant") seeks to register the mark WAVE RIDER ("Applicant's Mark"), for "Amusement products, namely, inflatable balls; Balls for games; Balls for sports; Hand balls; Paddle ball games; Paddle balls; Play balls; Playground balls; Sport balls; Squash balls; Stress relief balls for hand exercise" in International Class 28, as evidenced by publication of Applicant's Mark on December 22, 2015.
- 2. Opposer U.S. Fiber Glass Products, Inc., a Virginia corporation with a place of business at 1900 Cypress Avenue, Virginia Beach, Virginia 23451 ("Opposer") would be damaged by registration of Applicant's Mark and therefore opposes registration under 15 U.S.C. § 1063.
- 3. Opposer is a producer and distributor of surf boards and other sporting equipment, accessories, and clothing.

- 4. Opposer adopted and began using the mark WAVE RIDING VEHICLES in connection with its promotion and sales of sporting equipment, including surfboards and other goods related to water activities, as well as in connection with its promotion and sales of accessories and clothing.
- 5. Opposer is well and favorably known throughout the United States to the general consuming public and the trade for its WAVE RIDING VEHICLES Mark in connection with goods and services related to sporting equipment including surfboards, as well as clothing and other accessories. Moreover, as a result of Opposer's substantial investment in developing consumer goodwill in the WAVE RIDING VEHICLES Mark, the WAVE RIDING VEHICLES Mark is famous within the meaning of 15 U.S.C. § 1125(c).
- 6. To protect the use made of the WAVE RIDING VEHICLES Mark, Opposer has successfully registered that mark in the United States. Opposer exclusively owns incontestable United States Trademark Registration No. 1,527,014 for the mark WAVE RIDING VEHICLES for "clothing, namely, swimsuits, shirts, walking and running shorts, sweaters, sweat suits, coats and jackets, pants, blouses, skirts, dresses, t-shirts, and head dress, namely, hats, caps, and sun visors" in International Class 25, and for "surfboards, sailboards, skimboards, skateboards, flying disc toys and surfboard wax" in International Class 28. *See* Exhibit A. That mark has been continuously used in commerce throughout the United States since at least as early as July 1968.
- 7. Opposer also exclusively owns incontestable rights in United States Trademark Registration No. 2,829,673 for the WAVE RIDING VEHICLES Mark in International Class 35 for "wholesale, retail and online store services featuring men's, women's, and children's clothing, and accessories; swimwear; outdoor apparel; footwear; hats, caps and visors; games and toys; beach gear including surfboards, skimboards, bodyboards and surfboard wax; skateboards;

jewelry, including watches and watchbands, earrings, bolos and pendants; wallets and purses; videos and DVDs; travel accessories; luggage and bags; towels; seat covers; beach umbrellas and beach chairs; and miscellaneous goods conventionally sold in surf shops." *See* Exhibit B. That mark has been continuously used in commerce throughout the United States since at least as early as January 1967.

- 8. By virtue of the long, exclusive and continuous use of the distinctive WAVE RIDING VEHICLES Mark for surfing-related sporting goods and accessories and for clothing, such goods and services have become well and favorably known to the general consuming public and the trade under such marks. The WAVE RIDING VEHICLES Mark represents valuable symbols of Opposer's goodwill.
- 9. Applicant applied to register Applicant's Mark in connection with "Amusement products, namely, inflatable balls; Balls for games; Balls for sports; Hand balls; Paddle ball games; Paddle balls; Play balls; Playground balls; Sport balls; Squash balls; Stress relief balls for hand exercise." Applicant purports to use Applicant's Mark in connection with goods that are related to the goods for which Opposer has used the WAVE RIDING VEHICLES Mark for several decades.
- 10. Applicant states in its application that Applicant's Mark has been used in commerce since July 2015. There is no issue as to priority, as Opposer has used the WAVE RIDING VEHICLES Mark consistently in interstate commerce in connection with its goods and services since as early as 1968, long before Applicant applied to register or began using Applicant's Mark. Moreover, the WAVE RIDING VEHICLES Mark became famous long before Applicant applied to register Applicant's Mark.

FIRST GROUND FOR OPPOSITION Likelihood of Confusion

- 11. Paragraphs 1 through 10 are incorporated and made a part of this Ground for Opposition.
- 12. The WAVE RIDING VEHICLES Mark and Applicant's Mark are substantially similar, as the dominant portion of each mark "WAVE RIDING" and "WAVE RIDER" are nearly identical. The similarity between the appearance, sound, connotation, and commercial impression of the two marks indicates that a likelihood of confusion exists. By adopting the core component of the WAVE RIDING VEHICLES Mark, Applicant's Mark conveys the same overall meaning as the WAVE RIDING VEHICLES Mark.
- 13. The goods for which Applicant seeks to register Applicant's Mark are closely related to goods and services provided by Opposer, as both sets of goods are being marketed and offered for sale to be used with water-related sports and activities, and are sold through the same channels of commerce.
- 14. Because of the similarity between Applicant's Mark and Opposer's WAVE RIDING VEHICLES Mark, and between the parties' goods and services, consumers and the general public are likely to be confused, mistaken or deceived as to the origin and sponsorship of Applicant's goods and/or services and misled into believing that Applicant's goods and/or services offered under Applicant's Mark are provided by, or are in some other way directly or indirectly associated with Opposer to the damage of Opposer and its reputation.
- 15. Opposer has no control over the nature or quality of Applicant's services. In the event of false association, any defects, objections or faults found with Applicant's services could inflict serious injury upon Opposer and its reputation.

SECOND GROUND FOR OPPOSITION

Dilution

16. Paragraphs 1 through 15 are incorporated and made a part of this Ground for

Opposition.

17. The WAVE RIDING VEHICLES Mark is a distinctive and famous trademark

within the meaning of 15 U.S.C. § 1125(c), and became famous before Applicant applied to

register Applicant's Mark. The WAVE RIDING VEHICLES Mark is advertised and used

extensively throughout the United States, and is instantly recognizable by the consuming public.

Further, Opposer actively polices the use of the WAVE RIDING VEHICLES Mark by third

parties.

18. Registration of Applicant's Mark is likely to dilute by blurring the WAVE

RIDING VEHICLES Mark by impairing the distinctiveness of the WAVE RIDING VEHICLES

Mark.

19. Registration of Applicant's Mark is likely to tarnish the WAVE RIDING

VEHICLES Mark by associating it with goods and/or services that do not meet the standards of

quality associated with the WAVE RIDING VEHICLES Mark.

WHEREFORE, Opposer prays that Application Serial No. 86/712,479 be rejected, that

no registration be issued thereon to Applicant, and that this Opposition be sustained.
