Petitioner's motion filed March 16, 2006 to extend testimony periods and to extend dates for service of deposition transcripts is granted as uncontested. Trademark Rule 2.127(a).

The testimony periods are reset in accordance with petitioner's motion. The deadline for the service of deposition is extended sixty days to May 17, 2006.

Additionally, the Board notes that the parties have sought numerous extensions of time since petitioner commenced this cancellation in 1992. In the event the parties seek any further extensions of time or suspension of proceedings, the parties must provide a detailed report on the progress of their settlement negotiations to establish good cause for any continued suspension. Their report must include a recitation

of issues that have been resolved, a recitation of issues that remain to be resolved, and firm timetable for resolution.

Absent such a report, any future motion to extend or suspend may not be approved, even though agreed to by the parties.
