


MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEEDING AND RESET TESTIMONY PERIOD

Bell Packaging Corp. (hereinafter "Registrant"), by and through its attorneys, hereby moves the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board (the "Board") to (1) suspend the above-referenced cancellation proceeding until the disposition of Registrant's Motion to Quash Notice of Deposition and related motions filed December 12, 2002 and Petitioner's Brief in Opposition to Respondent's Motion to Quash and related motions, and (2) to reset Registrant's testimony period to run from the date of the Board's decision thereon. It is Registrant's understanding that the Board's standard practice is to automatically suspend the proceeding upon the filing of such motions and to reset the testimony period upon the disposition of the same. However, since Registrant did not specifically request that the Board suspend the proceeding and reset Registrant's testimony period in Registrant's previously filed Motion to Quash and related motions, Registrant respectfully makes this request now.

Good cause exists for Registrant's request, this request is not brought for purposes of delay, and there will be no prejudice to the non-moving party if this motion is granted by the Board. Registrant believes that, without a ruling on its Motion to Quash and related motions and the resulting Brief in Opposition filed by Petitioner, Registrant will lack information necessary to adequately prepare to notice and take testimony.

Since this is an unconsented motion seeking a suspension and an extension of the testimony period, Registrant hereby requests that the new testimony period be set to run from the date of the Board's decision on Registrant's Motion to Quash and related motions. Since this motion is being filed without consent of the nonmoving party, it is being submitted in single form.
