

TRADEMARK TRIAL AND APPEAL BOARD

RESPONSE TO REGISTRANT'S MOTION TO STRIKE

Petitioner, Boyds Collection, Ltd. (hereafter "Petitioner") hereby responds to Herrington & Company's, Inc. (hereafter "Registrant"), Motion to Strike Petitioner's Notice of Reliance.

In Registrant's Motion to Strike, Registrant argues that Petitioner's Notice of Reliance should be stricken on substantive and procedural grounds.

I. INTRODUCTION

During Petitioner's Testimony period, Petitioner filed a Notice of Reliance with the TTAB on April 22, 2002. Petitioner became aware that the Notice was not served to Opposing Counsel on August 5, 2002 and served a copy of the Notice to opposing counsel on August 20, 2002.

Registrant then filed the instant Motion to Strike Petitioner's Notice of Reliance September 10, 2002.

II. ARGUMENT

Registrant's Objection Not Appropriate

Registrant argues substantive points as to why the Petitioner's Notice of Reliance should be stricken. Particularly, Registrant focuses on Exhibit A (hereafter "Ausherman Declaration") and argues multiple substantive points as to why it should be stricken. First, the Registrant's objection is untimely. Second, the objected to documentary evidence has proper foundation and is of proper form. These points will be discussed below:

Registrant's Objection is Untimely

In accordance TBMP § 718.02(c), objections to a Notice of Reliance on substantive grounds normally should be raised in the objecting party's brief, rather than by a motion to strike. See also 37 CFR §2.123(k), and FRCP 32(d)(3)(A). In general, the TTAB does not examine trial evidence prior to a final decision. See TBMP §502.01. In deciding a substantive matter, determination of the motion will be deferred by the Board until final hearing. See *Weyerhaeuser Co. v. Katz*, 24 USPQ2d 1230 (TTAB 1992) and *M-Tek Inc. v. CVP Systems Inc.*, 17 USPQ2d 1070 (TTAB 1990). As such, Petitioner contends that any argument presented by Registrant relating to a substantive evidentiary matter be denied.

Documentary Evidence

a. Object-to documentary evidence has proper foundation and is of proper form

Registrant broadly asserts that the documents of Exhibit B-L lack the necessary foundation to be submitted as admissible evidence. Petitioner disagrees. The very nature of Exhibits B-L lends credence to their materiality, relevance and competency. Exhibits B-L all have a copyright notice bearing the TBC mark. Since TBC Herrington's Teddy Bear Club is the mark that is being scrutinized for cancellation, the relevancy of said Exhibits are that they tend to prove a prior use of the TBC mark by Petitioner. Petitioner's use of the TBC mark is corroborated by the copyright notice and publication date adjacent to the TBC mark on Petitioner's Exhibits B-L.

The admissibility of Exhibits B-L by means of a Notice of Reliance is also proper. 37 CFR § 2.122 (e) specifically allows for the submission of printed publications into evidence by means of a Notice of Reliance. The catalogs and price sheets of Exhibits B-L fall directly into

the category of printed publication defined under 37 CFR § 2.122 (e). Registrant tries to differentiate "literature", "catalogues", and "price sheets" from the statutory stated "publication". Petitioner contends however, by merely bifurcating Petitioner's Exhibits into categories of "literature", "catalogues" and "price sheets", said Exhibits still meet the "printed publication" standard under 37 CFR § 2.1233(e).

In light of the foregoing, Petitioner submits that Exhibits B-L of Petitioner's Notice of Reliance is relevant and material to these proceedings.

b. Exhibits A-L are Properly Labeled

Registrant argues that since Exhibits B-L were not consecutively numbered, the Board, per 37 CFR § 1.123 should refuse entry or consideration of said Exhibits. However, 37 CFR § 1.123 is not found in the latest publication of the Federal Register. Attached hereto as Exhibit 1 is a printout of a Lexis Search, current through September 5, 2002, indicating no such rule.

It appears that attorneys for Registrant are confused on the labeling of Exhibits A through L, by means of single successive letters of the English alphabet. Their confusion is illustrated by footnote 1 on page 3 of Registrant's Motion to Strike in that the "Ausherman Declaration makes no reference to and does not attach an Exhibit A." While it is unequivocally true that the Ausherman Declaration does not make a reference to Exhibit A, it is equally true that the Ausherman Declaration is labeled as Exhibit A. Petitioner's Notice of Reliance plainly corroborates that the Ausherman Declaration is Exhibit A. (See Exhibit 2, pg. 1 ¶ 2). Petitioner has made every effort to label all submitted Exhibits such that the Exhibits are cross-referenced with Petitioner's Notice of Reliance. Furthermore, Petitioner's Notice of Reliance plainly sets forth the lettering and description of submitted Exhibits (See Exhibit 2, pg. 1-2).

Petitioner believes that there is no procedural deficiency with the labeling of the Documentary Evidence. However, assuming **arguendo** that there is defect, Petitioner believes that any such defect is curable. In accordance with TBMP §718.02(b), the Board allows for the party which filed a Notice of Reliance time in which to cure a defect if the defect is curable. See *Weyerhaeuser Co. v. Katz*, 24 USPQ2d 1230 (TTAB 1992); *M-Tek Inc. v. CVP Systems Inc.*, 17 USPQ2d 1070 (TTAB 1990); and *Heaton Enterprises of Nevada Inc. v. Lang*, 7 USPQ2s 1842

(TTAB 1988).

Procedural Deficiencies

a. Late Service of Notice of Reliance is not Prejudicial to Registrant

It is undisputed that Petitioner mistakenly failed to served Registrant with a Notice of Reliance otherwise timely filed with the TTAB. (See Petitioner's Response to Motion for Judgment.) Petitioner contends that an equitable remedy exists such that Registrant will not suffer any prejudicial effects of the delay in service. Petitioner reiterate its request that the TTAB by reset the time period for Registrant to response and submit testimony, so as to rectify any prejudice to Registrant.

III. CONCLUSION

Petitioner requests that the Board deny Registrant's Motion to Strike. The arguments presented by Registrant is untimely inasmuch as they require a substantive evidentiary determination. As to any the procedural deficiency presented by Registrant, the deficiency can be remedied by resetting the time period for Registrant to respond to the Notice of Reliance and submit Testimony.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests that the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board deny registrant's Motion to Strike.
