My client, Scan Vision Screen ApS, has passed along to me your letter of July 30, 2002 concerning the above. Judgement by default should not be entered against the respondent in this case for the following reasons.

Petitioner and respondent, two Danish companies, have been negotiating and have now concluded settlement negotiations. Pursuant to the settlement, petitioner will withdraw the present cancellation proceedings, such that trademark registration No. 2,041,296 for "HOLOSCREEN" will remain valid.

It is my understanding that such proceedings will be withdrawn prior to the present due date of August 29, 2002, but for the sake of good order, I respectfully request a


