Petitioners' Motion To Reopen
Petitioners' Testimony Period
Pursuant to F.R.Civ.P. Rule 6(b)

Petitioners respectfully move this Honorable Board to
reopen Petitioners' Testimony Period in the above styled matter,
and as grounds therefore Petitioners state as follows:



This Motion is supported by the attached Declarations of Robert M. Schwartz, counsel for Petitioner in these proceedings, and Julie M. Lamdanski, trademark administrator for Robert M. Schwartz.

Petitioners hereby request that the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board at least extend the testimony period in the above-referenced Opposition, and reset the dates in the proceeding as follows:

Testimony period for party in position
of Plaintiff to close (opening thirty
(30) days prior thereto): February 23, 2005

Testimony period for party in position
of Defendant to close (opening thirty
(30) days prior thereto): April 21, 2005

Rebuttal testimony period to close
(opening fifteen (15) days prior
thereto): June 7, 2005

Background of the proceedings to date.

The Consolidated Petition to Cancel was filed February 27, 2004. The Petition was mailed to Registrant March 8, 2004 and Registrant's Answer was served April 16, 2004. Discovery has been served by Petitioners and Registrant. Neither party has responded. An agreement was made between the parties to extend the time for Petitioners to respond to discovery until November

15, 2004, with a condition that Registrant would respond with responses to the discovery immediately after Petitioners' responses were received by Registrant. Petitioners filed a first request for an additional period of time to respond to discovery until December 15, 2004. Petitioners filed a second request for an additional period of time to respond to discovery until January 15, 2005. Registrant, pursuant to the said condition has not yet responded to Petitioners' discovery requests. Pursuant to the Board's March 8, 2004 trial dates, "Plaintiff's" testimony period expired December 23, 2004.

Pursuant to Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Rule 6(b), a party may request an enlargement of time by motion made after the expiration of the specified period, where the failure to act was the result of excusable neglect.

It is within this Board's discretion to enlarge or reopen an expired time period when the failure to act is due to excusable neglect. Pursuant to TBMP section 509.01(b) Motions to Reopen Time, the analysis for determining excusable neglect must take into account all relevant circumstances surrounding the party's omission or delay, including (1) the danger of prejudice to the nonmovant, (2) the length of the delay and its potential impact on judicial proceedings, (3) the reason for the

delay, including whether it was within the reasonable control of the movant, and (4) whether the movant acted in good faith.

Pioneer Investment Services Company v. Brunswick Associates Ltd. Partnership, 507 U.S. 380 (1993), adopted by the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board in *Pumpkin Ltd. V. The Seed Corps*, 43 USPQ2d 1582 (TTAB 1997).

1. The danger of prejudice to the nonmovant.

In the present instance, there is no prejudice to the nonmovant. As shown above, the parties have still not exchanged discovery. Therefore, an extension of time for "Plaintiff's" testimony period would not have been unexpected and would have, in fact, been expected in view of the extensions of time for exchange of discovery between the parties. Petitioners could not take the testimony of either party until receiving responses by Registrant to Petitioners' discovery.

2. The length of the delay and its potential impact on judicial proceedings.

In the present instance, the length of delay, in requesting an extension of time for "plaintiff's" testimony period, to reopen the testimony period is short. This motion is filed within one week of the close of plaintiff's testimony period.

There is no or minimal impact on the judicial proceedings because the parties have not yet finished exchanging discovery.

3. The reason for the delay, including whether it was within the reasonable control of the movant.

As set forth in the attached supporting Declarations, which are incorporated herein, the delay was a result of an unexpected and unavoidable failure of counsel's docketing system to report the deadline date, the close of "plaintiff's" testimony period. All dates had been timely and properly input into the docket system, and all dates had been reviewed in the Firm's normal processes. The error here should be considered excusable neglect in view of the circumstances set forth herein.

Specifically, what has now been determined, the docket system converted the deadline date December 23, 2004 as entered, from the close of plaintiff's 30 day period, to the beginning of the period, November 23, 2004. The only date reported in reminder lists was the opening date of November 23, 2004, not the closing date. Although both the start date (beginning of period) and the closing date of the period were both in the system, the reminder list the firm prints out monthly (attached to declaration of Julie Lamdanski) did not report the closing

date of plaintiff's testimony period and thus the unexpected and unavoidable failure.

Therefore, counsel's reliance on the docketing system was misplaced and resulted in the missing of the deadline date of the close of plaintiff's testimony period.

Though the attorney of record had a docket system and procedures in place for entering of dates, and the docket system was checked regularly, and the critical date was entered into the docket system properly, the deadline date was not printed out. As a result the date was missed.



At all times the movant has acted in good faith. There is no intentional delay of proceedings.





DECLARATION OF ROBERT M. SCHWARTZ

1. The undersigned is counsel for Petitioner in the above captioned proceeding.
2. I have used the FLEXTRAC brand docket system (FLEXTRAC Systems Inc., Georgetown, Texas) in my own law firm and

the present law firm for at least the past 10 years.

This docket system was adopted by my present Firm four years ago when I joined the Firm as a Partner.

3. Julie Lamdanski, is the trademark administrator for the Firm's IP group, and is responsible for docketing trademark matters, including both trademark prosecution matters and inter-parties proceedings and printing and monthly Reminder List and advising myself of due dates.
4. In the above proceeding, (Trademark Trial and Appeal Board order of March 8, 2004), Plaintiff's Testimony period was set to close on December 23, 2004. This date was timely entered in the docket system. However, as shown in the Reminder List printouts attached to the declaration of Julie Lamdanski, the reminder date for the end of the period, was not automatically generated and printed by our docketing system, even though this date was correctly entered into the docket system. See Declaration of Julie Lamdanski.
5. It is the responsibility of the trademark administrator to print out and review the trademark docket Reminder List monthly. This was timely and properly done. In the December 2004 Reminder List, Exhibit C attached to Julie Lamdanski's Declaration, there was no reminder entry for the end of Plaintiff's testimony period. The reminder

date for the beginning of Plaintiff's Testimony Period was in the November 2004 Reminder List see Exhibit B attached to Julie Lamdanski's Declaration.

6. If a reminder had been generated by the docket system for "Plaintiff's Testimony Period to Close", then that date would have shown up on the December Reminder List which is generated and printed monthly, and the due date would not have passed as it did.
7. Prior to the events described herein, it was not realized that reminder dates were not printed for the date of "Plaintiff's Testimony Period to Close."
8. In order to prevent this from happening again, Reminder Rules have now been set up in the Firm's docket system to automatically generate reminder dates for the closing of all discovery and testimony periods in inter parties proceedings.
9. In addition, I have instructed our trademark administrator to update all our pending Trademark Trial and Appeal Board matters in our docket system to ensure that all reminders appear correctly, in order to avoid this happening again. This has now been performed.
10. Further, I will be advising the vendor of the docket system of this situation.

11. Upon discovering of the missed deadline, upon my return from vacation on Monday December 27, 2004, I immediately advised counsel for registrant and requested an agreement to extend or "reopen" plaintiff's testimony period. Counsel could not agree. See Exhibit A attached hereto.
12. In the present proceeding, the parties had each served discovery. The parties had mutually agreed, to the time for Petitioners to respond, extending the time until November 15, 2004, with a condition that Registrant would respond after Petitioners.
13. Due to personal family health problems of one of Petitioners, it became necessary to formally request from the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board a further 30 day extension, (Registrant could not agree to the extension). At this time on November 11, 2004, I first suggested in writing to counsel for Registrant the discovery extensions would impact testimony periods, Exhibit B attached hereto. On November 15, 2004 the undersigned further requested counsel for Registrant to agree to a 30 day extension for the testimony and rebuttal periods. See Exhibit C attached hereto. No agreement was reached.
14. On December 15, 2004, Petitioner's undersigned counsel prepared and filed a request for a second extension to the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board to respond to

discovery when the father of one of Petitioner's passed away. The same day, December 15, 2004 the undersigned dictated a letter to Registrant's counsel regarding extensions of the testimony and rebuttal periods. The intent was to file the request to extend these testimony and rebuttal periods, prior to the undersigned leaving on a one week vacation December 19, 2004.

15. The dictation was not transcribed by the undersigned's secretary, until after counsel returned from vacation. See transcribed letter and history of dictation and transcription dates attached as Exhibit D.
16. Docket deadlines were reviewed prior to leaving for vacation. Since the deadline date did not appear on the docket sheet Reminder List, the deadline was not picked up prior to leaving for vacation and the deadline was missed.




