plaintiff. This was based on the withdrawal from this matter by my law
firm, Ruden
McClosky Smith Schuster & Russell, P.A. due to the fact that my
attorney at that firm,
Robert M. Schwartz, had left their employ. As a result of Mr.
Schwartz's departure, I
have had difficulty in obtaining all of the relevant information and
work prepared on my
behalf from Ruden McClosky. Although I do have a significant amount in
my
possession, that I have reviewed for purposes of moving forward with
this matter, I am
still in the process of trying to retrieve certain documents from the
Ruden firm.

As a result of the above, and due to the voluminous nature of th
e
paperwork that

has been generated on this matter by both sides, and by the fact that I am currently representing myself primarily due of a lack of resources, I have been unable to make the necessary progress required on the matter to date. The complexity and substantive nature of the relevant issues require additional review.

I understand that the Board has already granted Petitioners an extension of time on this matter based on a motion originally submitted by Robert Schwartz dated November 15th, 2004. Now that Mr. Schwartz and his firm are no longer the attorneys for Petitioners however, I respectfully ask for one more brief but necessary continuance to properly prepare.

Wherefore, based on good cause shown and not for purpose of delay, Petitioners respectfully request extension of time of one (1) month to complete the 30-day testimony period for party in position of plaintiff to close.
