4. Respondent is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of the averments set forth in Paragraph 4 of the Petition, and they are therefore denied.

5. Respondent is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of the averments set forth in Paragraph 5 of the Petition, and they are therefore denied.

6. Respondent is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of the averments set forth in the first, second and third sentences of Paragraph 6 of the Petition, and they are therefore denied. Respondent denies the averments set forth in the fourth sentence of Paragraph 6.

7. Respondent denies the averments set forth in Paragraph 7 of the Petition.

WHEREFORE, Respondent prays that this Cancellation be dismissed with prejudice.


