On October 2, 2006, the Board granted respondent's counsel motion to withdraw as attorney of record and allowed respondent thirty days in which to appoint new counsel or inform the Board that respondent chooses to represent itself. The Board suspended these proceedings pending respondent's response.

On October 2, 2006, respondent appointed new counsel.

Accordingly, proceedings herein are resumed and respondent is allowed until **twenty days** from the mailing date of this order to respond to petitioner's motion (filed September 26, 2006) to amend the petition to cancel.

Trial dates, including the close of discovery, are reset as follows:¹

THE PERIOD FOR DISCOVERY TO CLOSE:	December 28, 2006
30-day testimony period for party in position of plaintiff to close:	March 28, 2007
30-day testimony period for party in position of defendant to close:	May 27, 2007
15-day rebuttal testimony period to close:	July 11, 2007

In each instance, a copy of the transcript of testimony together with copies of documentary exhibits, must be served on the adverse party within thirty days after completion of the taking of testimony. Trademark Rule 2.125.

Briefs shall be filed in accordance with Trademark Rules 2.128(a) and (b).

An oral hearing will be set only upon request filed as provided by Trademark Rule 2.129.

¹ In light of the instant order, petitioner's motion (filed October 5, 2006) is deemed moot and will be given no further consideration.
