**OPPOSITION TO REGISTRANT’S REQUEST FOR LEAVE TO FILE LATE ANSWER**

Petitioner, FPPF Chemical Co., Inc. (“FPPF”), by and through its undersigned attorney, requests that Registrant’s motion entitled “Request For Leave To File Late Answer” be denied. In the Board’s order dated May 30, 2006, Registrant was requested to show cause why judgment by default should not be entered against it in accordance with Fed. R. Civ. P. 55(b). As acknowledged in Registrant’s motion, good cause requires a satisfactory evidentiary showing that the delay in filing was not the result of willful conduct or gross neglect on the part of the defendant. *See TBMP §312.02; DeLorme Publishing Co. v. Eartha’s Inc., 60 USPQ2d 1222, 1224 (TTAB 2000)*. However, Registrant’s motion consists of nothing more than attorney argument, without any supporting affidavit or declaration under penalty of perjury.

Statements in pleadings and briefs generally do not constitute evidence. *TBMP §704.06*. Fed. R. Civ. P. 43 similarly provides that “[w]hen a motion is based on facts not appearing of record the court may hear the matter on affidavits presented by the respective parties . . . .” No

such testimony has been presented in support of Registrant's assertion of good cause, and Registrant's motion should be denied based on a failure of proof.

Moreover, there is affirmative evidence indicating that Registrant's failure to file a timely response to the Cancellation Petition was in fact due to gross neglect. First, the prosecution file for Registration No. 2,968,113 shows that Registrant received all prosecution-related correspondence addressed to the 1350 East Flamingo Road address in Las Vegas, Nevada. Although Registrant failed to timely respond to the Notice of Allowance and had to revive its application (Serial No. 78/160,058), the one-month delay was not said to be due to any failure to receive the Notice of Allowance. Instead, Registrant asserted in a Statement of Use cover letter that it was confused and had sent its documents in an incorrect manner, causing the delay.<sup>1</sup> See paragraph 1 and Exhibit "A" of attached Duft Declaration. Insofar as Registrant regularly received and responded to correspondence sent from the USPTO to the East Flamingo Road address, it is difficult to imagine that it did not receive the Cancellation Petition or the Scheduling Order.

Second, Registrant has been aware of Petitioner based on a letter sent to Registrant on April 5, 2005 advising that Registrant's Application Serial No. 78/160,058 for the mark POWER FUEL had been cited as a potential bar to Petitioner's registration of FUEL POWER. Registrant was requested to voluntarily withdraw its application based on Petitioner's superior rights, or face a cancellation proceeding. See paragraph 2 and Exhibit "B" of attached Duft Declaration.

<sup>1</sup> Curiously, the prosecution record shows no attempted filing of any documents after the Notice of Allowance and prior to the Statement of Use.

Third, Petitioner's counsel spoke via telephone on March 16, 2006 with Rachael East, an employee of Registrant. Ms. East acknowledged receipt of the April 5, 2005 letter. She was also verbally advised of Petitioner's intention to file the present cancellation proceeding. She replied that she would speak to Wanda Lewis, another employee of Petitioner, regarding a possible amicable resolution of this matter. No response was thereafter received by Petitioner from any representative of Registrant until the recent filing of Registrant's papers in this proceeding. See paragraph 3 of attached Duft Declaration

For the reasons set forth above, it is respectfully requested that Registrant's Request For Leave To File Late Answer be denied and that default judgment be entered.



Dear Ms. Lewis:

This office represents FPPF Chemical Company of Buffalo, New York (FPPF) in connection with the enforcement of its intellectual property rights, including trademarks. I am writing you regarding the above-referenced application filed by Power Research, Inc. (PRI) to obtain federal registration of the mark POWER FUEL for a "chemical fuel additive for gasoline, diesel fuel and heavy diesel fuel oil."

FPPF is the owner of the mark FUEL POWER for a chemical additive for the treatment of diesel fuel, as indicated in the enclosed photocopy of an FPPF advertising flyer. FPPF applied for federal registration of the FUEL POWER mark in Application Serial No. 76/585,481, filed on April 5, 2004. This application is based on FPPF's actual use of the FUEL POWER mark in interstate commerce dating back to February 1975, which use has been nationwide in scope and continuous since its inception.

In a first office action mailed in connection with the '481 application, the USPTO cited the '058 application on the ground that there may be a likelihood of confusion between the FUEL POWER and POWER FUEL marks. The '481 application has been placed on suspension to await the disposition of the '058 application. Presumably, if the '058 application matures into a federal registration, the determination of likelihood of confusion made in connection with the '481 application will be finalized and FPPF will be denied a registration for its FUEL POWER mark.

A review of the prosecution history for the '058 application reveals that PRI filed its application based on an intent to use, and has recently filed a statement of use alleging first use in 1999 and first use in commerce in 2000. Given that FPPF's first use of FUEL POWER began some 25 years prior to PRI's first use of POWER FUEL, FPPF has priority. It would be deemed to have superior rights should this matter need to be resolved by the

USPTO in the context of a petition to cancel PRI's registration (should it receive one) or by a federal court in the context of a trademark infringement action brought by FPPF.


You should also be aware that the specimens submitted with PRI's statement of use do not appear to evidence actual trademark use, even as of the date of submission of the statement of use. The specimens are website pages in which the identifier Powerfuel® appears on some of the pages, but not on any of the illustrated products. I suspect that you will receive a rejection of the statement of use on this ground, together with an admonition regarding improper use of the ® symbol when there is no registration.

Insofar as PRI is not entitled to registration for the mark POWER FUEL given FPPF's prior use of FUEL POWER for the same goods, FPPF hereby requests that PRI formally abandon its '058 application, thereby removing this application as an impediment to issuance of the '481 application. FPPF further requests PRI's agreement that it will discontinue all promotional use (including website use) of the term Powerfuel® (and variants thereof) in connection with fuel additives, it being FPPF's position that such use is likely to cause confusion, mistake or deception among members of the consuming public.

Should PRI not agree to the foregoing, and should it continue to pursue a federal registration based on the '058 application, FPPF will have no choice but to initiate a cancellation proceeding to effect cancellation of any such registration. Moreover, FPPF will be forced to consider appropriate enforcement action under state and federal trademark statutes governing trademark infringement.

Please indicate your response to the foregoing as soon as possible so that FPPF can advise the USPTO regarding the status of this matter. If we do not hear from you by April 19, 2005, it will be assumed that PRI does not agree to the foregoing requests.




