PETITIONER'S SECOND MOTION FOR SANCTIONS.



01-15-2009

Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 2.120(g), petitioner Live Ventures Inc. ("Petitioner" or "Live Ventures") hereby moves for discovery sanctions against registrant Saroj International, Inc. ("Registrant" or "Saroj") for failure to abide by the Order of December 12, 2008, of the Board in this proceeding ("Order" or "Board's Order"). In the alternative, Petitioner moves for a continuance of the Discovery Period so that Petitioner has an opportunity to file a motion for summary judgment. Petitioner submits that, absent sanctions, a continuance is warranted in view of Registrant's failure to comply with the Board's Order because Petitioner would have had sufficient time to move for summary judgment, had Registrant complied with the Board's Order. Finally, Petitioner also moves that the proceedings be stayed pending resolution of this motion.

This motion is supported by the declaration of Norbert Stahl ("Stahl Dec"), filed herewith with Exhibits A through G attached thereto.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A. On December 12, 2008, the Board Ordered Registrant to Serve Supplemental Discovery Within 20 Days or Risk Judgment Against It.

On December 12, 2008, the Board ordered Registrant to provide within 20 days the supplemental discovery that the Board had already ordered on February 21, 2008 that Registrant provide to Petitioner ("Supplemental Discovery"). Specifically, Registrant was ordered to serve the Supplemental Discovery via email. December Order, at 6.

In the Order, the Board put Registrant on notice that "if it fails to comply with the Board's order above, judgment will be entered against it and in favor of petitioner." Order, at 7.

B. When Petitioner Asked Registrant for the Overdue Supplemental Discovery, Registrant Asked Petitioner to Join a Stipulated Request for Relief from the December Order.

On January 5, 2009, Petitioner wrote a letter to Registrant asking for the Supplemental Discovery because none of the discovery and no notice of any kind had been received. Stahl Dec., Ex. A. On January 6, 2009, Petitioner wrote another letter to Registrant again asking for the Supplemental Discovery. Stahl Dec., Ex. B.

On January 8, 2009, Registrant responded with a letter stating that the Supplemental Discovery was allegedly emailed in compliance with the December Order. Registrant's counsel, Mr. Gary Eastman, however, admitted that

compliance with the Order [of December 12, 2008,] appears to be impossible as I have attempted to send the E-mail several times.

Stahl Dec., Ex. C, 3rd para. (emphasis added).

Registrant requested that Petitioner join a stipulation to relief Registrant from the December Order:

I would request your authorization to submit a Stipulated Request for Relief from Order authorizing delivery, in this instance only, via Federal Express.

Please let me have your immediate response.

Stahl Dec., Ex. C, 3rd para. On January 8, 2009, Petitioner received for the first time a letter from Registrant, dated December 31, 2008, which purports to transmit the Supplemental Discovery. Stahl Dec., Ex. D.

On January 8, 2009, Petitioner responded to Registrant by asking for immediate delivery of the Supplemental Discovery with competent evidence in the form of a Proof of Service showing that the Supplemental Discovery was served pursuant to the

December Order. Stahl Dec., Ex. E (including the email from counsel for Registrant). Petitioner further responded that it will review Registrant's evidence of timely service to decide if another motion for sanctions is warranted. *Id.*

C. In the Afternoon of January 12, 2009, the Supplemental Discovery Ordered by the Board Was Delivered to Petitioner, Together with Other Responses that Were Long Overdue and Not the Subject of the Board Order.

On January 12, 2009, at 2:27 p.m., the Supplemental Discovery was delivered to Petitioner. Stahl Dec., Ex. F. The only Proof of Service (*i.e.*, Certificate of Service) that Registrant delivered with the Supplemental Discovery stated that Registrant was "[u]tilizing Federal Express Certificate No. 796240899160 on January 8, 2009" (Stahl Dec., Ex. G, p. 2) and the Proof of Service further requested:

Please acknowledge receipt of the following documentation made in compliance with the Order of the TTAB dated December 12, 2008

Stahl Dec., Ex. G, p. 1.

In addition to the Supplemental Discovery, Registrant also served, for the first time, responses to Petitioner's

- (i) Second Set of Requests for Admissions, served March 19, 2008;
- (ii) Second Set of Requests for Documents, served April 2, 2008;
- (iii) Second Set of Interrogatories, served April 23, 2008.

Stahl Dec., Ex. G, p. 2; ¶10.

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ARGUMENT

A. For the Second Time in These Proceedings, Registrant Failed to Abide by an Order of the Board.

Registrant failed to serve the Supplemental Discovery on Petitioner in accordance with the Board's Order of December 12, 2008 in this case. Prior to that, Registrant filed to abide the the Board's Order of February 21, 2008, ordering Registrant to provide the Supplemental Discovery, and thus eventually resulting in the Board's second order, demanding again that Registrant finally serve the discovery in question.

Registrant stated that "**compliance with the Order** [of December 12, 2008,] **appears to be impossible as I have attempted to send the E-mail several times.**" Stahl Dec., Ex. C, 3rd para. (emphasis added). If "the E-mail" did not transmit to Petitioner after "several" attempts, then Registrant was well aware that service had not been accomplished pursuant to the Board's Order. If, for example, the "E-mail" was too large for email transmission, it would be a simple task to break attachments down into smaller files and transmit those separately. Petitioner submits that Registrant cannot evade compliance with the Board's Order by "failing" at transmitting an email.

Petitioner notes that sending the small amount of papers that constitute the Supplemental Discovery from San Diego, California (the location of the offices of counsel for Registrant), to the Bay Area, California (the location of the offices of counsel for Petitioner), is simple, fast, cheap and easy. Failing in this task cannot be explained in a manner that is consistent with a willingness to honor and follow any, let alone all, of the applicable rules of procedure and conduct, or the Board's Order.

Registrant's tactics prejudice Petitioner and they have forced the Board and

Petitioner to expend considerable time and resources in this case without accomplishing any progress in resolving the issues before the Board. Moreover, as the case schedule is short, even short delays have significant substantive impact as they prevent Petitioner to pursue resolution. It is for these reasons that Petitioner has declined Registrant's request to join a "Stipulated Request for Relief from Order" (Stahl Dec., Ex. C, 3rd para.).

Petitioner also notes that the discovery responses that Registrant served and that were not covered under the Board's Order show the dramatic extent to which Registrant has been uncooperative in these proceedings because the corresponding requests were served by Petitioner in March and April of 2008.

Petitioner therefore requests that the Board grant this request for sanctions and enter judgment against Registrant and for Petitioner by cancelling Registrant's marks at issue in these proceedings.

B. In the Alternative, Petitioner Requests a Continuance of the Discovery Period in this Case.

If the Board finds that Registrant's conduct satisfies an acceptable level of cooperation, then Petitioner moves in the alternative for a continuance of the discovery period so Petitioner has time under 37 C.F.R. § 2.127 to file a Summary Judgment motion on the issue of priority and Registrant's fraud on the Trademark Office. Registrant's multiple delays made it impossible to bring a Summary Judgement motion at an earlier time during these proceedings.

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Petitioner also moves that the proceedings be stayed pending resolution of this motion.



I, Norbert Stahl, declare as follows:

1. I am an attorney licensed to practice in the State of California and registered to practice before the United States Patent and Trademark Office and I am a member of Stahl Law Firm. I represent Petitioner Live Ventures Inc. (Petitioner or "Live Ventures") in Cancellation No. 92047661 and I submit this declaration and statement of good faith effort in support of Petitioner's Second Motion for Sanctions against Registrant Saroj International, Inc. 


