**STIPULATED MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL EXTENSION OF TIME TO ANSWER OR

Registrant, LABORATOIRES DE BIOLOGIE VEGETALE YVES ROCHER, and
Petitioner, 4392132 CANADA INC., through its attorneys, hereby respectfully requests that the
period of time in which Registrant may answer or otherwise respond with respect to Petitioner's
Petition for Cancellation be extended for an additional thirty (30) days. The Answer or other


