Pursuant to the notice issued March 22, 2012, by the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board (“TTAB”) to the parties to this Cancellation Action, Respondent hereby provides a report of the status of the federal district court action entitled, *VV Sterling v. C. Casey Bennett, et al.* CV 07-08127 GW (Ex) (the “Action”), which occasioned the suspension of the presently suspended Cancellation proceeding

I. Status Of Federal Civil Action

On or about July 20, 2011, the parties in the Action informed the Court that the parties reached a settlement of all claims at issue therein. (Document #164). On August 11, 2011, pursuant to the settlement reached, the action was dismissed with the Court retaining jurisdiction to enforce the settlement. (Document #166). Accordingly, the Action is no longer pending within the Central District of California. All claims therein made have been resolved through a confidential settlement agreement.
