PETITION TO CANCEL

CHERUBS - The Association of Congenital Diaphragmatic Hernia Research, Advocacy and Support, also known as CHERUBS - The Association of Congenital Diaphragmatic Hernia Research, Awareness and Support, having its place of business at 3650 Rogers Rd. #290, NC 27587, has been and believes it will continue to be damaged by the continued registration of the mark shown in United States Trademark Registration 3,503,325 and hereby seeks cancellation of this registration.

As grounds for the cancellation, CHERUBS - The Association of Congenital Diaphragmatic Hernia Research, Advocacy and Support, alleges:

- 1. DESCRIPTION OF REGISTRANT'S REGISTRATION No. 3,503,325: Filed on April 1, 2008 by Breath of Hope, Inc. the mark CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS "Promoting public awareness of congenital diaphragmatic hernia; Public advocacy to promote awareness of congenital diaphragmatic hernia", claiming first use in commerce on 07/01/2007. Registered on September 17, 2008 on the Supplemental Register.
- 2. FRAUD BY BREATH OF HOPE, INC.: Breath of Hope, Inc., filed an application for the registration of the mark CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS on April 1, 2008.
- 3. Breath of Hope, Inc., stated in its application that it first used CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS in commerce at least as early as July 1, 2007.
- 4. Upon information and belief, Breath of Hope, Inc., did not first use CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS in commerce as early as July 1, 2007.
- 5. Upon information and belief, Breath of Hope, Inc., did not use CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS in its newsletter published in July 2007.
- 6. Upon information and belief, Breath of Hope, Inc., used the "TM" symbol on its Web site in conjunction with CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS DAY and not with the mark as shown in the application.

- 7. Upon information and belief, prior to October 22, 2007, Breath of Hope, Inc., used the "TM" symbol in conjunction with CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS DAY and not CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS on its graphics.
- 8. Upon information and belief, prior to October 22, 2007, Breath of Hope, Inc., used the "TM" symbol in conjunction with CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS DAY and not CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS on its blog.
- 9. Upon information and belief, Breath of Hope, Inc., shortened the mark CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS DAY to CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS on or after October 22, 2007.
- 10. GENERIC USE OF THE TERM CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS: Congenital diaphragmatic hernia is a birth defect that affects approximately 1600 babies each year in the United States, taking the lives of approximately 800 of these children.
- 11. Congenital diaphragmatic hernia is a common medical problem. It affects 1 in every 2500 babies. It occurs as often as Spina Bifida and Cystic Fibrosis. Every 10 minutes, somewhere in the world a baby is born with congenital diaphragmatic hernia.
- 12. CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS is a term commonly used by the patients, medical care providers and other organizations affected by congenital diaphragmatic hernia. Congenital diaphragmatic hernia is often abbreviated as CDH and the term CDH awareness is used.
- 13. Over 4000 people, including officers from 8 congenital diaphragmatic hernia organizations and many doctors and nurses have signed an on-line petition against this trademark for this common phrase, CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS.
- 14. THREAT OF HARM TO OUR NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION: CHERUBS was founded in February, 1995 to support families affected by congenital diaphragmatic hernia, to research congenital diaphragmatic hernia and to advocate for awareness of congenital diaphragmatic hernia.
- 15. Since at least as early as 2000, CHERUBS has been using the term awareness in correlation with congenital diaphragmatic hernia in the marketplace.
- 16. Since at least as early as 2000, CHERUBS has been using term CDH AWARENESS in the marketplace, using the common abbreviation of CDH for congenital diaphragmatic hernia.
- 17. On January 4, 2008 CHERUBS began the necessary paperwork to change our public name to and be Incorporated as CHERUBS The Association of Congenital Diaphragmatic Hernia Research, Awareness and Support with our registration of an Employer Identification Number.
- 18. THREAT OF HARM TO OUR NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION: CHERUBS has been threatened with this trademark since October, 2007. The first threats came immediately following a civil restraining order case filed by DAWN M. TORRENCE, President & Founder of CHERUBS against ELIZABETH DOYLE-PROPST, CEO and Founder of BREATH OF HOPE, INC that was dismissed only on the grounds that it would be better suited as a corporate tort suit.
- 19. On several occasions BREATH OF HOPE, INC. has contacted CHERUBS with threats of lawsuits sent to both our President and our lawyer. Cafepress.com, Yahoo.com, Zazzle.com and Google.com were contacted in an attempt to have our charity's site removed from their listings and our fundraising store taken down because of our use of the common term CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS.

- 20. On September 18, 2008, Cafepress.com was contacted by ELIZABETH DOYLE-PROPST, CEO and Founder of BREATH OF HOPE, INC, requesting that CHERUBS on-line fundraising store be altered or removed because of our use of the term CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS.
- 21. On November 17, 2008, Zazzle.com notified CHERUBS that ELIZABETH DOYLE-PROPST, CEO and Founder of BREATH OF HOPE, INC, requested removal of fundraising products on CHERUBS account that contained the phrase "Congenital Diaphragmatic Hernia". This is the name of the disease and not the registered phrase, but ELIZABETH DOYLE-PROPST claimed registered ownership of this phrase.

It is my opinion that the United States Trademark Registration No. 3,503,325 for CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS would be extremely detrimental to our organization, families affected by congenital diaphragmatic hernia, raising money to fund medical research of congenital diaphragmatic hernia and other organizations created to assist these families affected by congenital diaphragmatic hernia.
