Microsoft hopes people get touchy on their PCs
Windows 7 includes ability to interact with touch-screen

Most every computer user is a whiz at pointing and clicking with a mouse. If Microsoft has a say, you'll become equally adept at touching and tapping the PC screen directly with your fingers.

As part of the company's recent launch of Windows 7, the vastly improved successor to Windows Vista, Microsoft hopes to usher in a new era for touch-based computing. And that means smudging your paw prints all over the surface of the screen -- to finger paint, play music, spin a globe or enlarge and rotate photos.

Multitouch, or the ability to manipulate the display screen with one or more fingers, is built directly into Microsoft's latest operating system. "We believe in touch," Microsoft CEO Steve Ballmer says.

You'll need hardware with special touch-capable screens. Acer, Asus, Dell, Fujitsu, Gateway, Hewlett-Packard, Lenovo, Sony, Toshiba and other PC makers have or will shortly trot out touch-ready computers with Windows 7.

With the technology fused into Windows 7, PC companies and software developers can apply their own touches on top of the operating system.

On HP's TouchSmart 600t all-in-one PC, for example, you can tap tiles to launch Twitter and recipe applications. In a Rhapsody music application, you can search for an artist or song by "writing" the name directly on the screen with your fingers.

The SimpleTap feature on Lenovo's ThinkPad T400s laptop lets you turn on Wi-Fi, alter volume and brightness and handle other basic functions by tapping onscreen tiles.

"Direct manipulation is easier to interact," maintains Ian LeGrow, a group product manager on the Windows team at Microsoft. "Our task is to make these habit-forming."

Such a task won't come easy. Because of years of doing it one way, you may well be inclined to reach for the mouse and keyboard even when there's a touch alternative.

While the ergonomics may seem unnatural at first, the truth is that folks touch computer screens all the time, getting cash at an ATM, receiving boarding passes at the airport or printing pictures at a photo kiosk. And you're a master of touch if you carry an iPhone or certain other smartphones. HP has suggested that touch is great for "walk-up computing" -- quickie behaviors such as browsing photos or consulting a family calendar.

"The great thing about touch is you don't have to teach anybody," says John Cook, a marketing vice president at HP. Joe Roberts, an executive vice president at Corel, adds, "I think it's unlearning -- that you don't need your mouse and keyboard to do this."

The demand for touch-screen PCs is rising. Amy Leong, research director at the Gartner research firm, says the number of touch-screen PC units shipped will surpass 6 million in 2010, nearly quadrupling 2008 shipments. She says about 10% of the new PC models coming this year will support touch technology. According to iSuppli forecasts, the global market for touch-screens will reach \$6.4 billion by 2013, up from \$3.4 billion in 2008.

'In search of an application'

It'll take time for the software to catch up. "Touch is technology in search of an application right now," says Michael Cherry, an analyst at Directions on Microsoft, an independent research firm.

Some software -- digital drawing programs, for instance -- lend themselves naturally to touch. For example, Corel Paint it! Touch is a new \$40 program designed specifically with touch in mind. You can take a photograph and apply a painting style to it (watercolor, impressionist, etc.) by tapping the screen.

SpaceClaim is about to bring out sophisticated 3D modeling software for engineers that exploits multitouch. It's not for consumers, but it shows off the possibilities. You can pan, rotate and zoom in on 3D models. "It's like something out of Minority Report," says Blake Courter, co-founder of the Concord, Mass., company.

Ubisoft has been previewing R.U.S.E., a wartime strategy game that will be among the first to take advantage of multitouch in Windows 7.

But turning the mouse and keyboard into benchwarmers is, at best, a touch-and-go proposition. In fact, touch is meant to augment and complement the mouse and keyboard rather than supplant them.

"Some things are just inherently easier to do with touch," says Al Monro, CEO of NextWindow in New Zealand, a supplier of optical multitouch displays for major manufacturers. For example, rather than click through menu commands to resize fonts on the screen, you can just touch the text directly to make it happen. From Microsoft's point of view, touch is one of the "natural user interfaces" -- vision, ink and speech are others -- that reflect a longtime passion of co-founder Bill Gates. The touch capabilities built into the latest Windows share elements with the 30-inch interactive tabletop computers known as Microsoft Surface, which Microsoft first deployed in 2008.

Early Surface tables are in hotels, cruise ships, retail stores and other businesses. From the tabletop, you can order drinks or display maps. Eventually, some cheaper version of the tables might show up in your living room; you or the kids might use them to play games or splatter digital photos across the surface.

Touch has barely scratched the surface on home computers, but putting the capability in the operating system ought to make it more accessible to consumers -- and it opens up all sorts of possibilities for programmers. "I think it helps any technology get more popular if it's included in Windows," Ballmer says.

There are still challenges. Take price. "If it costs me an extra \$20, I'll probably get (touch)," Monro says. "If it's an

extra 500 bucks, probably not."

Dell says the rough premium on its touch-ready Studio 17 notebook will be about \$100 over a similar system without touch. The Lenovo premium is about \$400. If touch machines gain traction, you can expect prices to fall.

Microsoft has been championing touch in Tablet PCs for some time. But though useful for students who take handwritten notes or among business users who must fill out forms, the machines barely make a blip among the masses. Tablets use a digital pen or stylus. That's not the case with the new crop of mainstream-oriented touch PCs.

Despite the push from Microsoft, the main impetus behind touch these days, at least for ordinary folks, comes from rival Apple. "The iPhone is the real kicker to the touch industry," says Amichai Ben-David, CEO of Israel-based touch-screen hardware maker N-trig.

For its part, Apple has resisted the kind of touch-screen computers now emerging from the PC camp. But there's speculation, if no actual confirmation from Apple, that the company might unveil a multitouch-based tablet computer relatively soon.

In the meantime, Apple is marketing touch technology in other ways, apart from the iPhone or iPod Touch. The entire top surface of its brand-new \$69 Magic Mouse is a multitouch sensor. You can run your finger across the surface of the Bluetooth mouse to scroll in any direction. Or you can use swiping gestures with two fingers to navigate Web pages or to browse pictures. It takes a little getting used to, and you don't get the full multitouch experience as on an iPhone.

Let your fingers do the talking

To help make touch easier to grasp on PCs, Microsoft has enlarged icons in Windows 7 for the Start Menu, Taskbar and Windows Explorer. In lieu of the mouse, you can open and shut programs by directly tapping or double-tapping with your fingers. You can summon a virtual onscreen keyboard, too, though it's nowhere near as natural as typing on a physical keyboard.

You can also zoom in on a picture by spreading two fingers apart, or zoom out by pinching them back together. And you can "right-click" by holding down one finger while you tap the screen with a second finger.

Windows 7 can support up to 100 touch points, Microsoft says, though there are hardware constraints (screen size) and the genetic reality of having just so many fingers with which to perform gestures. The behavior on the screen changes depending on how many fingers you use.

Microsoft is making available a free Windows 7 Touch Pack with a Surface-like photo collage application and a few simple games. The idea is for you to become more proficient at using gestures. In Blackboard, you're meant to solve a puzzle by dragging and rotating gears, seesaws and other game pieces with your fingers against a virtual blackboard. In Garden Pond, the object is to move origami around a pond by creating ripples with your fingers.

If touch ever takes off in a big way, consumers may have to shop differently. Just as you now might eyeball a screen and bang away at a keyboard when comparing models side by side, you may eventually also test a new variable: how responsive a screen is to your touch.

The sense of touch on home PCs is still evolving. But a strong commitment by Microsoft via Windows 7, along with improvements to touch-screen hardware, makes it intriguing technology whose time may have finally come.

Touching on 3 multitouch models

I've been trying out "multitouch" on three new Windows 7 models: the third generation of Hewlett-Packard's TouchSmart 600t all-in-one PC as well as two touch-based laptops, Dell's Studio 17 and the Lenovo ThinkPad T400s.

On balance, I liked all three, and I liked having the option to touch the screen directly even if old habits are hard to break. (I sometimes felt more comfortable relying on the traditional mouse and keyboard.) Let me quickly touch on the trio:

HP TouchSmart 600T (available now, \$1,050 and up, after rebate). You can drag and click tiles to launch apps for Hulu, [Netflix](#), Twitter and more, including HP's own Recipe Box. You can leave notes and draw directly on the screen -- or capture and apply special effects to webcam videos, just by tapping on the screen.

But the computer was frustrating at times. When I tried installing a TV programming guide as part of the (optional) TV tuner setup, I had to enter my ZIP code with the physical keyboard. On another program, I could use only an on-screen keypad to put in my ZIP code.

You can tap the screen to summon TV channels, but it wasn't instantaneous. I also hit snags with the Hulu app. When dark, the screen smacked of fingerprints.

Dell Studio 17 (\$899 and up, available soon). Handsome 17-inch display could be more responsive to touch at times.

The Surface Lagoon screen saver (part of [Microsoft Touch Pack](#)) is a cool way to show off the technology. Press the screen, and water ripples. Press and hold, and fish swim toward your finger, as if you're about to feed them.

Lenovo ThinkPad T400s (\$1,999 and up, available now). Multitouch on a thin, light, solid -- and yes, pricey -- business laptop. Through a feature dubbed SimpleTap, you can turn on Wi-Fi, mute the microphone, adjust brightness and handle other functions. Lets you create and customize your own tiles to open programs, files or Web pages.


The Acer Aspire T180 is hobbled by its single-core Athlon processor. It placed last on our multimedia tests, so I can recommend it only for light use and Web browsing. Still, on the plus side, it comes with 90 days of Norton AntiVirus, and it's bloatware-free. It also has the most internal tool-less expansion space. The Aspire is one of the more stylish value PCs, and it is the least expensive desktop in our lineup. That said, the other choices here are a lot more computer for not a lot more money.

Performance was good, albeit middle-of-the-pack. Drawbacks include a short Norton Internet Security subscription (60 days) and a lot of bloatware. Still, there's a lot to like here for the majority of users.



While in the Kitchen, Stir the Stew and Surf the Web

DREAM kitchens may soon include a computer along with the latest refrigerator or oven. That way people gathered at the family hub can satisfy their digital needs along with nutritional ones.

Hewlett-Packard's new TouchSmart IQ770 PC (\$1,699 at Circuit City) is designed for that kitchen of the future, where people turn on the computer along with the coffeepot, and then check the screen for the weather, ball scores and the family calendar as they breakfast.

The calendar on the TouchSmart is easy to use. Entries can be written on the touch-sensitive screen with a finger or stylus, or entered on a keyboard, so that everyone knows what's ahead during the day, from the dentist at 9 a.m. to the PTA at 7 p.m.

The computer also has a high-definition TV receiver, a DVD player and a 19-inch screen that moves up and down as well as tilting, so that people having a snack at the counter or a nearby table can watch their favorite show or video. Putting a computer in the kitchen is not a new idea. Neiman Marcus, the department store, included an ad for a Honeywell kitchen computer, priced at \$10,600, in its 1969 Christmas catalog, said Dag Spicer, senior curator at the Computer History Museum in Mountain View, Calif.

The ad featured a woman in need of a computer to manage recipe quantities and carried the slogan, "If she can only cook as well as Honeywell can compute." But Mr. Spicer said the marketing campaign failed. "As far as we know, Neiman Marcus didn't sell a single computer."

The latest generation of kitchen computers may be more successful, and not just because the ads are less patronizing. The difference instead may lie in the spread, and speed, of broadband connections and the way that, in turn, is changing people's computer habits.

"Forty-seven percent of all American adults have a broadband connection at home as of early 2007," said Mary Madden, a senior research specialist at the Pew Internet and American Life Project. That connection has prompted people to do more and more on the computer, from video-watching to discarding phone books and cookbooks in favor of online research. "Once people get that always-on connection," she said, "they do more of everything online."

Much of this home Internet activity is happening not in the study, but in shared living spaces, she said. Seventy-four percent of teenagers who use the Internet at home, for instance, do so in a shared space.

Hewlett-Packard's new computer is designed for these communal spots, said Amy Clark of Granger, Ind., who was sent a TouchSmart for review on her Web site, www.momadvice.com. She put it in the kitchen-dining area, and it promptly became a family focal point. In the morning, she checks the calendar; in the evening, she and her husband watch movies on it. "It also helped reduce some clutter," she said. The family also downloaded hundreds of CDs that were once scattered around the house on it.

The touch-sensitive screen on the TouchSmart is optically driven -- it has two cameras that track hand positions, so that people can use their fingers to play computer solitaire or chess, for instance, if they don't want to use the mouse or keyboard. Gloved hands work well, too, as do hands with a bit of left-over spaghetti sauce on them. The screen comes clean with Windex.

People taken with the idea of a computer in the kitchen don't necessarily have to buy one from a manufacturer like Hewlett-Packard. They can economize by assembling one from components. Bill Ekhardt, a Presbyterian pastor taking time off to care for his three preschool-aged children in Des Moines, did just that -- after first trying to make do in the kitchen with a laptop. That didn't work, as the laptop could easily be pulled down from the counter and wrecked by the children, he said.

SO when he upgraded his desktop computer in the study, he decided to recycle the leftovers to make a reasonably childproof kitchen computer. He installed the processor from his old computer in a kitchen cupboard, and mounted the monitor on an arm that he bought online.

The mounting arm swings out above the kitchen counter.

"I angle the screen down so the kids can see it, or angle it up so that I can see it from where I'm cooking," he said.

He uses the computer to check the weather, or catch an occasional headline, e-mail messages or a streaming radio show. The arm was about \$70 at www.newegg.com; the wireless keyboard and mouse, about \$30.

His 2-year-old son Asher gets to watch the occasional entertainment on the monitor, but there are conditions.

"I let him play 'Thomas the Tank Engine,' " a preschool video game, said Mr. Ekhardt. "But only if he takes a good nap first."

Tool removes the grunt work from college planning

Software lets advisers compare schools, eligibility for aid

New software automates the college selection process and financial planning, eliminating hours of manual work for financial advisers.

Smart Search, from Stratagee Corp. in Russell, Pa., automates the process of researching schools, removing most of the tediousness from the process. In less than 45 minutes, advisers and families can identify colleges and generate an estimate of the net cost of attending — taking into account financial aid, academic scholarships and other grants.

The web-based program allows advisers to compare schools, estimates the chances a student has of being accepted and eligibility for financial aid. Experts said that this is the first time that a single technology can answer the questions: Can a student get into a particular school? And can the family afford the room and board?

Smart Search “appears to be a handy little tool, especially for doing quick analysis,” said Rick Darvis, executive director of the Plentywood, Mont.-based National Institute of Certified College Planners, which provides courses that lead to a designation in college planning. Unlike other college search software, it can determine the likelihood of a student's being admitted, he said.

An adviser inputs a student's standardized-test score and grade point average, some basic financial information and search criteria such as specific majors or college locations.

Once the information is entered, the adviser can generate a report that includes the name and website for each college, the student's chance of admission and a cost estimate for each school.

In addition, the platform estimates the amount of aid a student could receive and the net cost to the family after loans and grants are factored into the equation.

The technology is a relief to clients who otherwise would rely on pencil and paper to determine the schools their children would consider, and determine if they could afford to attend them by virtue of some back-of-the-envelope calculations.

Russell Certo, a physical therapist in Grand Island, N.Y., and his wife went through the “extremely painful and time-consuming process” of planning their oldest daughter's college admission on their own.

As a result of the experience, he asked his adviser, Jim Miller, a certified financial planner in nearby Buffalo, N.Y., to assume a leading role in college planning for Mr. Certo's remaining kids.

Mr. Miller put together a list of 10 schools for Mr. Certo's 17-year-old son, Benjamin, including Harvard University in Cambridge, Mass., which is considering him as a potential hockey recruit.

“Oh my, was this ever so much simpler and so much less of a headache,” Mr. Certo said. “You can plug things in and take things out, and you are not ruling out the expensive schools just based on cost.”

To be sure, college planning has frustrated advisers because of the time required to develop a strategy.

“When I first started [working on Section 529 college savings plans], I was spending eight or more hours putting [them] together,” said Troy E. Miller, a CFP in Sacramento, Calif., who is no relation to Jim Miller.

As a result, the former started his own website, 529directory.com, in 2001 to help simplify the process for advisers, with free tools and a simple calculator. But Mr. Miller said that Smart Search is “comprehensive and extremely intuitive.”

“Now you can knock out a plan in anywhere from 15 to 45 minutes, not to mention being able to provide an entire page of reports and possibilities,” he said. “What Smart Search does is not only eliminate the schools you shouldn't be wasting your time on, but it allows for a more accurate assessment of all the possibilities in one program.”

Although no competitors exist that match the scope of Smart Search's features in a single product, advisers can rely on a couple of websites to generate similar information. However, these sites are likely to require more legwork because they aren't designed for advisers.

Collegeboard.com Inc. in New York offers an abundance of free resources under its “For Parents” section and five subsections, such as “Pay For College.” There are dozens of articles, frequently asked questions, and calculators are available that advisers can use if they are willing to invest the time to locate them.

Likewise, Peterson's, a subsidiary of Nelnet Inc. in Lincoln, Neb., offers a plethora of resources at petersons.com of which advisers can take advantage — if they are willing to take the time to explore the site.

However, advisers who attain the college-planning certification and join the NICCP can purchase additional tools and materials that will allow them to match, or surpass, Smart Search, several market participants said.

Smart Search is available at Stratagee.com and costs \$349 for an annual license that includes updates. In addition, the company plans to release a more advanced product, Strategy Software, a full-blown financial planning tool.

The cost is \$449 for an annual license that also includes updates.





