Since a trademark of service mark is supposed to distinguish your goods and services from those of others, it is important to conduct searches to ensure that no one else is using the desired mark already, or one which makes the desired mark ineffective or lacking in distinctiveness. Once cleared, an assessment must be made of how distinctive the mark will be and applications must be filed to register the selected mark. 
