MINUTE entry before Honorable Rebecca R. Pallmeyer: Ruling held on 11/4/2013. Defendant's motion to dismiss Plaintiff's First Amended Complaint [22] is granted. The allegations of Count I are inadequate even under liberal pleading standards, because they do not explain how, if at all, the TTAB erred. Count II fails because Plaintiff has not alleged that it is a competitor of Defendant. Count III states claims arising under state law only; those claims are dismissed without prejudice. The court notes, further, that it does not appear that Defendant has aimed any commercial activity at Illinois. Even if Plaintiff had made allegations sufficient to establish this court's personal jurisdiction, it is apparent that the Northern District of Illinois is not the appropriate venue for this dispute.
