On June 3, 2011, respondents filed a voluntary surrender under Section 7(e) of the Trademark Act of their Registration No. 3810448 with an allegation of settlement and of petitioner's written consent, but the written consent was not submitted.

Trademark Rule 2.134(a) provides that if the respondent in a cancellation proceeding applies to cancel its involved registration under Section 7(e) without the **written** consent of every adverse party to the proceeding, judgment shall be entered against respondent.

Accordingly, respondents are allowed until **THIRTY DAYS** from the mailing date of this order to provide the Board with a copy of the written consent from petitioner. If no word is

heard from the parties, judgment shall be entered against respondents, and the petition to cancel will be dismissed with prejudice. See Trademark Rule 2.134(a); and TBMP § 602.02 (3d ed. 2011).
