The other companies in the group involving steel refer to ParFab Industries, Inc. and ParFab Field Services, LLC (www.parfabfs.com); and Steel Mountain Group, LLC. Some of the owners/principals of Wohali Outdoors, LLC also are the owners/principals of these entities. None of Wohai's products are made of steel.

Supplemental Response to Interrogatory No. 10: Wohali incorporates by reference all previous objections and without waiving same, states: Golden Eagle was developed shortly after Steel Eagle as a sub brand in Wohali's line of fishing rods. Golden Eagle is Wohali's lowest end fishing rod.

Supplemental Response to Interrogatory No. 11: Wohali incorporates by reference all previous objections and without waiving same, states: Wohali has a line of fishing rods that


contain the name Golden Eagle. The first use in interstate and intrastate commerce was Spring 2009.



I am writing to follow up on Wohali's discovery responses and document production in this proceeding.

Wohali's Responses to Sheltered Wings' Interrogatories

Interrogatory Nos. 1 and 24: We note that in Wohali's response to these interrogatories, Wohali states that the term "Wohali is a Cherokee word for Eagle and other companies within the group involved steel." This statement is unclear; we would appreciate if you could clarify what is meant by "other companies within the group involved steel" and whether any aspects of Wohali's products are made out of steel. We also note that the response to this interrogatory explains that JT Griffin reviewed the need for a "series or 'sub line' trademark" and we would appreciate if you would explain what "series or 'sub line' trademark" means to Wohali.

Interrogatories Nos. 10-13: These interrogatories relate to information regarding marks including the term "EAGLE" and the mark GOLDEN EAGLE. We note that Wohali has not provided any substantive answers to these interrogatories and has objected on certain grounds, including that no definition of GOLDEN EAGLE has been provided. Although we do not think the term needs definition, this interrogatory requests information concerning Wohali's use of the term "GOLDEN EAGLE" in connection with any of its products or services. We also note that GOLDEN EAGLE is one of the registrations pleaded in this proceeding and information relating to Wohali's use of GOLDEN EAGLE is relevant to this matter. Please supplement your responses to interrogatories nos. 10-13 and please let us know if you are withholding information on the basis of any of the objections lodged by Wohali.

Interrogatories Nos. 19-23: These relate to Wohali's contentions concerning the "affirmative defenses" it pleaded in this case. We note that Wohali has objected to these requests (all in response to interrogatory no. 20) based on several grounds, including relevance,

breadth, vagueness, ambiguity, burden, and privilege. Please let us know whether Wohali is withholding any information in response to these interrogatories based on any of these grounds.

Wohali's Responses to Sheltered Wings' Requests for Production

Request for Production No. 5: This request relates to documents showing how the STEEL EAGLE mark has been used, advertised, or promoted by Wohali, and includes documents relating to advertising and promotional materials, marketing plans, and draft or intended promotional materials. We note that Wohali's response to this request says that additional documents will be produced if requested upon the entry of an appropriate protective order. We now have a stipulated protective order entered in the case and we request that Wohali produce any documents that it has been withholding on the basis of confidentiality in response to this and any other requests.

Requests for Production Nos. 7-8: We note that Wohali has stated that it will produce additional documents in response to these requests upon entry of a protective order and accordingly, we request that Wohali produce such documents.


Requests for Production Nos. 17-19: These relate to documents concerning Wohali's marks including the term "EAGLE" and including GOLDEN EAGLE, and we note that Wohali has objected to these requests on the basis that this cancellation pertains to STEEL EAGLE only. However, as noted above, the GOLDEN EAGLE mark owned by Sheltered Wings is one of the pleaded registrations in this cancellation proceeding and the documents requested are relevant to this matter. Please produce Wohali's documents in response to these requests.

Redactions: It appears that Wohali has redacted several documents including documents numbered WOHALI 000998, WOHALI 000692-707, and WOHALI 000709-710. Please let us know why these documents have been redacted.

Because discovery closes soon on March 19, we would appreciate if Wohali would supplement its interrogatory responses and produce any additional documents by **Friday, March 8, 2013**. We also understand that Wohali is withholding at least documents numbered WOHALI 000459-499 and WOHALI 000523-524 on the basis of attorney-client privilege or work product protection. We would appreciate if Wohali could provide its privilege log by March 8 as well. If you have any questions or concerns, please let us know.


Nikon offers an extensive lineup of binoculars — including several of the world's most popular series — for a diverse range of applications. Each model features various technical specifications that can help you in making the right selection. Magnification is usually considered most important, but field of view, brightness, ease of handling (weight, feel, ergonomics), suitability for eyeglass wearers and overall construction should also be taken into account.

Magnification

Magnification, represented by a numerical value, is the relationship between a subject's actual proportions and its magnified size. With X magnification, for example, a subject appears X times larger when viewed through binoculars than when viewed with the unaided eye. As a rule, magnifications of 8x to 10x are considered for handheld outdoor use. With magnifications of 12x or greater, any shaking by hand movement is more likely to create an unstable image and uncomfortable viewing.

Field of view

All binoculars use number codes to designate various specifications. In "7x40 8.8°," for example, "8.8°" represents the *real* field of view, which is the angle of the viewing field from the eyepieces to the horizon. The apparent field of view, or the angle of view observed through the eyepieces, is the angle of view that is needed to make the entire field of view at 1,000 metres. The specifications in this width of the visible area at a distance of 1,000 metres.



* Apparent field of view is calculated based on the ISO 9542:1982 method for details, see p. 56.

Objective lens diameter

The objective lens diameter, combined with the quality of lens and prism coatings, determines the amount of light gathered to form an image. If you are regularly observing in poor light conditions, such as early dawn or dusk, or in forested areas, you may need a larger objective lens. But large-diameter objective lenses make binoculars heavier, so 50mm is the general limit for handheld use.


Exit pupil

The exit pupil is the image formed by the eyepiece lenses. The diameter of the exit pupil (in mm) is the effective aperture divided by the magnification. The diameter of the human eye pupil varies from 2.3mm in daylight to 7mm in the dark. An exit pupil of 7mm gives maximum light to the dilated eye and is ideal for use in the twilight and at night.



Brightness

The relative brightness value is obtained by squaring the diameter of the exit pupil. The greater the relative brightness, the brighter the image will be. However, this value does not correspond to the actual brightness observed with the naked eye because light coming through the eyepieces is 100% effective only if the exit pupil is the same diameter as the pupil of the eye.



The following icons indicate the purpose for which each series is best suited:



Outdoor, camping, hiking
Regular outdoor activities demand portability and durability. Models that also feature early morning and evening use, binoculars with large objective diameter and Makro multi-coated lenses are recommended.



Birdwatching, nature watching
Binoculars with a wide field of view and 7x to 10x magnification are suited for general nature viewing. Observing waterbirds or birds at a greater distance is more comfortable with 8x to 10x magnification models. For even closer views, Fieldscopes are recommended.



Marine sports, fishing
Waterproof and durability are essential for these activities. Enhanced brightness and a wide field of view are desirable, too. Models that feature vibration reduction are favored for on-board use.



Spectator sports
Binoculars that feature a wide field of view and 7x to 10x magnification are handy for viewing sports events. Compact, lightweight models, too, readily attract and easy changes in magnification to suit the viewing situation.



Traveling
Compact, lightweight models with midrange magnification and field of view are ideal for traveling.



Theater
Compact models with magnification of 8x to 9x are recommended for theater and concert use. To focus on a particular performer, 7x to 10x models are more appropriate.



Stargazing
Astronomical observations require a high optical system with a large objective diameter and exit pupil. Waterproof and vibration-resistant binoculars are preferred.



Museum
Lightweight, compact, lightweight models with low magnification and a close focusing distance of less than 2m are recommended.



For eyeglass wearers
Choose a long eye relief (high eye point) design so that eyeglass wearers can also enjoy a full, clear field of view.

How to read the numerical information code for binoculars

All Nikon binoculars are designated with a numerical formula, such as "10x25.5 4°". The value "10x" indicates the magnification of the binoculars. If a person uses 10x binoculars to observe a wild bird from a distance of 100 metres, for example, it will appear to observe as if he or she were viewing the bird from a distance of 10 metres (100 divided by 10 equals 10) with the naked eye. The value "25.5" represents the objective lens diameter in millimetres. The value "4°" represents the angle of the visible field, as measured from the centre of the objective lenses. The greater the diameter of the objective lens, the brighter your image will be with the same illumination. Nikon's superior lens coatings also play a vital role in improving lens brightness. If the objective lens is too large, however, the binoculars will be heavy and may cause trembling of the hands. Finally, the number "5.4°" represents the real field of view of the binoculars. This is the angle of the visible field, as measured from the centre of the objective lenses. The bigger the value, the easier it is to locate an object. Understanding the meaning of these numbers should provide you with greater freedom in selecting and using binoculars.




