PETITION FOR CANCELLATION

Petitioner, 3M Company, a Delaware Corporation having its principal place of business at 3M Center, 2501 Hudson Road, St. Paul, MN 55144 (“Petitioner”) believes that it is being and will continue to be damaged by U.S. Trademark Registration No. 3,267,104 in Class 9 (the “Registration”) and hereby petitions for a cancellation of the same under the provisions of 15 U.S.C. § 1064.

As grounds for this cancellation, Petitioner asserts that:

1. 3M is the owner of the 3M Mark and trade name (collectively the “3M Mark”). 3M commenced use of the 3M Mark at least as early as 1906 in connection with abrasive products. Since that time, 3M has continuously used the 3M Mark in commerce in the United States.

2. Over the past century, 3M has expanded its use of the 3M Mark and presently offers over 70,000 products and services in a wide variety of fields under the 3M Mark. These products include a wide range of automotive, audio/video and electronics products.

3. Over the years, 3M has presented its 3M mark in a number of different formats, as depicted in Exhibit 1.

4. In 1978, 3M introduced the current 3M logo (“3M Logo”).

5. In addition to its extensive common law rights, 3M owns over 200 United States registrations for the 3M Mark.

6. 3M is the owner of the following representative United States trademark applications and registrations for its 3M Mark and 3M Logo:

All of the above U.S. Trademark Registrations are valid, subsisting, and enforceable and are incontestable pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1065. Copies of these registrations are attached as Exhibit 2.

7. As a result of 3M's long use and promotion of its 3M Mark and 3M Logo, the 3M Mark and the 3M Logo have become distinctive to designate 3M, to distinguish 3M and its products and services from the products and services of other businesses, and to distinguish the source or origin of 3M's products and services. As a result of 3M's efforts, the consuming public throughout the United States widely recognizes and associates the 3M Mark and 3M Logo with 3M and its products and services.

8. The 3M Mark and 3M Logo are inherently distinctive.

9. 3M's 3M Mark and 3M Logo are famous marks.

10. On September 15, 2006, BM Audio Labs, Inc. ("Respondent") filed U.S. Trademark Application Serial No. 76/666,151 which led to U.S. Registration No. 3,267,104 for the design mark BM BM AUDIO LABS ("Respondent's Mark") registered in International Class 9 for "automobile audio systems and components, namely, radios, amplifiers, tuners, speakers, compact disc players, video disc players, DVD players, TFT Monitor and cable" ("Respondent's Goods").

11. Respondent's Mark is shown below:



12. The highly stylized "B" of Respondent's Mark appears as a "3", creating the same visual impression as "3M".

13. Respondent's Goods are complementary to and related to 3M's automotive and electronics products offered under its 3M Mark.

14. The 3M Mark and 3M Logo became famous prior to any use of Respondent's Mark and prior to the filing of Application Serial No. 76/666,151 for Respondent's Mark.

15. Upon information and belief, for the past three years or longer, Respondent has not used Respondent's Mark with any of Respondent's Goods or any other goods in the United States or in U.S. commerce.

16. On information and belief, Respondent does not intend to resume any use of Respondent's Mark in connection with the goods described above.

17. Pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 1127, non-use of a mark with no intent to resume use constitutes evidence of abandonment. In turn, non-use of a mark for three consecutive years constitutes *prima facie* evidence of abandonment. Thus, Respondent has abandoned any rights it had in Respondent's Mark and the corresponding registrations should be cancelled. 15 U.S.C §§ 1064, 1127.

18. Additionally, Respondent's Mark so resembles the 3M Mark and 3M Logo as to be likely, when used on or in connection with Respondent's goods, to cause confusion, or to cause mistake, or to deceive. Purchasers and prospective purchasers are likely to mistakenly believe that the goods offered under Respondent's Mark are sponsored, endorsed, or approved by 3M, or are in some way affiliated, connected, or associated with 3M. Cancellation is therefore appropriate under 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d).

19. When used on or in connection with Respondent's goods, Respondent's Mark so resembles the 3M Mark and 3M Logo that it is likely to cause dilution of the distinctive quality of the 3M Mark and 3M Logo in violation of 15 U.S.C. § 1125(c).

20. 3M has been and will continue to be damaged by registration of Respondent's Mark, because the Registration provides Respondent with a *prima facie* exclusive right to use

such marks, along with the other statutory presumptions, and such registration is a source of damage to 3M based on 3M's extensive use and promotion of the 3M Mark and its enormous goodwill in that mark as described above.

WHEREFORE, 3M believes that it is being, and will continue to be, damaged by the continuing existence of Respondent's Registration.

WHEREFORE, pursuant to 15 U.S.C. §§ 1052(d), 1064, 1125 and 1127, Petitioner requests that U.S. Registration No. 3,267,104 be cancelled, and that this Petition for Cancellation be sustained.

The filing fee in the amount of \$300.00 required by 37 C.F.R. § 2.6(a)(17) is being paid electronically via credit card with this Petition to Cancel. The Commissioner is authorized to draw on the deposit account of Fulbright & Jaworski L.L.P., Account No. 50-1212/10708600/THRT277/MSM, in the event that anything prevents the successful completion of electronic payment of the filing fee.
