This case now comes up on the parties' stipulated motion (filed March 9, 2012) to amend respondent's Registration No. 3876628 and to dismiss the cancellation, contingent upon entry of the amendment.

By the proposed amendment to its registration, respondent seeks to change the identification of goods in Registration No. 3876628

from:

Audio headphones; Audio speakers; Consumer electronic products, namely, audio amplifiers, audio speakers, audio receivers, electrical audio and speaker cables and connectors, home theater systems, audio decoders, video decoders, speakers, power conversion devices, power converters, and power inverters; Power supply connectors and adaptors for use with portable electronic devices; Wireless receivers and

transmitters for portable media players; Wireless transmitters and receivers

to:

Power supply connectors and adaptors for use with portable electronics; wireless receivers and transmitters for portable media player; wireless transmitters and receivers

Although the amendment appears otherwise acceptable, the request to amend was neither (1) verified or supported by a declaration under Trademark Rule 2.20, nor (2) accompanied by the proper fee. See Trademark Rules 2.6(a)(11) and 2.173.

Accordingly, respondent is allowed until thirty days from the mailing date of this order to submit the appropriate fee and to properly verify or support the April 8, 2010 amendment to the registration, failing which the proposed amendment will be given no further consideration.
