On October 30, 2013, registrant filed a motion to divide its involved Registration No. 1217199, with petitioner's consent. Specifically, registrant requests that the services in International Class 42 "Custom Fabricating and Fitting of Artificial or Natural Hair Pieces to the Scalp to Correct Baldness" are to remain in the present registration, and the goods in International Class 3 "Hair Care Preparations-Namely, Shampoo and Conditioner" are to be the subject of a newly issued registration, which will be assigned to petitioner.

Pursuant to TMEP § 1615.01, TBMP § 516, and 37 CFR §2.171(b)(1), a party requesting division of a registration must (1) record the change of ownership with the Assignment Recordation Branch of the USPTO; (2) file a request to

divide; and (3) pay the fee required by 37 CFR §2.6(a)(8) for each new registration created by the division.¹

Registrant has satisfied elements 2 and 3 above, however, with regard to element 1, registrant is allowed thirty days from the mailing date of this order in which to record the assignment of the goods in International Class 3 to petitioner and provide the Board with the Reel/Frame numbers.

Pending a response from registrant, proceedings herein are suspended.
