Inasmuch as Petitioner's copy of the August 29, 2015 order to show cause was returned as undeliverable, the Board issues this substitute order.

Show Cause

On July 6, 2015, Respondent filed a notice of final disposition of the civil action between the parties. By way of the notice, Respondent asks the Board to "enter judgment in Respondent's favor and dismiss the [Board] Cancellation action with prejudice" consistent with the findings in the Judgment entered against Petitioner in the civil action. *See* 8 TTABVUE 2.

In view of the district court's Order (dated May 15, 2015) and Judgment (dated May 28, 2015), attached to Respondent's July 6th filing, Petitioner is allowed until **thirty days** from the mailing date of this order in which to **show cause** why

judgment should not be entered against Petitioner in this Board proceeding and the Petition for Cancellation dismissed with prejudice.

Petitioner's Correspondence Address

Twice in this proceeding copies of correspondence to Petitioner have been returned to the Board as undeliverable. If a party to a Board proceeding or its attorney moves, a separate written notice of the change of address should be filed with the Board. It is the responsibility of a party to a proceeding before the Board to ensure that the Board has the party's current correspondence address. If a party fails to notify the Board of a change of address, with the result that the Board is unable to serve correspondence on the party, default judgment may be entered against the party. *See* TBMP § 117.07 (2015).

Inasmuch as Steven Rinehart, of Western IP Law, counsel of record for Petitioner, has filed a more recent appearance in an unrelated Board proceeding (*see* 24 TTABVUE in Opposition No. 91214407), the Board has updated counsel's address as a one-time courtesy to Petitioner.
