By the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board:

On March 26, 2015, the Board issued a notice of default for Petitioner's failure to file an answer in this proceeding. The Board allowed Petitioner time to show cause why default judgment should not be entered against it. On May 6, 2015, with no response by Petitioner having been filed, the Board granted the cancellation proceeding and cancelled Petitioner's involved registrations, Registration Nos. 3907646 and 4093914, by way of Commissioner's Order dated May 21, 2015. On May 20, 2015, Petitioner filed a stipulation to set aside default judgment and to dismiss the cancellation proceeding, which has now come to the Board's attention.

The Board finds good cause to set aside default judgment for the reasons provided in Petitioner's stipulation. Accordingly, the motion to set aside judgment is granted, judgment by default is set aside, and Registration Nos. 3907646 and 4093914 will be forwarded to the Commissioner for Trademarks for reinstatement.

This proceeding is now dismissed in accordance with the parties' stipulation.¹
