Registrant's consented motion (filed January 6, 2015) to suspend this proceeding for settlement negotiations is granted.

Because the parties are negotiating for a possible settlement of this case, proceedings are suspended up to, and including April 14, 2015, subject to the right of either party to request resumption at any time. *See* Trademark Rules 2.117(c), and 2.127(a); and TBMP § 605.02.

In the event that there is no word from either party concerning the progress of their negotiations, upon conclusion of the suspension period, proceedings shall resume on April 15, 2015 without further notice or order from the Board, upon the schedule set forth below.

Respondent is allowed until May 15, 2015 in which to answer the petition for cancellation. Conferencing, disclosure, discovery and trial dates are reset as follows:

In each instance, a copy of the transcript of testimony together with copies of documentary exhibits, must be served on the adverse party within thirty days after completion of the taking of testimony. Trademark Rule 2.125.

Briefs shall be filed in accordance with Trademark Rules 2.128(a) and (b). An oral hearing will be set only upon request filed as provided by Trademark Rule 2.129.

If, during the suspension period, either of the parties or their attorneys should have a change of address, the Board should be so informed.¹
