**REGISTRANT’S REPLY IN SUPPORT OF REGISTRANT’S  
MOTION TO SUSPEND PENDING OUTCOME OF ANOTHER  
PROCEEDING OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, TO EXTEND TIME TO ANSWER**

WeMesh, Inc. (“Registrant” or “WeMesh”) submits this reply in support of Registrant’s Motion to Suspend Pending Outcome of Another Proceeding or, in the Alternative, to Extend Time to Answer (“MTS”).


In opposing WeMesh’s MTS, Petitioner WeMash, Inc. agrees that suspension is appropriate. TTABVUE Dkt. 5 at 2. For that reason alone, the Board should grant Registrant’s MTS.

WeMash suggests, however, that the Board should suspend the proceedings in 60-day increments (id.) – effectively requiring Petitioner or Registrant to file motions to suspend every 60 days while the district court proceeding, or motion to dismiss, are pending. That is inefficient, a waste of Registrants’ and the Board’s time, and not in the interests of judicial economy. As with any suspension order, the Board here will ask the parties for an update, as soon as the district court matter is concluded. TBMP 510.02(b) (“When a proceeding before the Board has been suspended pending the outcome of another proceeding, and that other proceeding has been finally determined, the interested party should promptly notify the Board in writing of

the disposition of the other proceeding, and request that further appropriate action be taken in the Board proceeding.”). That alone obviates the need for imposing 60-day suspension periods.

Accordingly, Registrant’s MTS should be granted.
