Sergio Rios Gutierrez, an individual (hereinafter, "Respondent"), with a mailing address of 722 West 132nd Street, Gardena, CA 90247, for the stylized mark **GRUPO LA MIGRA** plus design in international class 041 for "entertainment, namely, live performances by a musical band," with a claimed date and approved by UNITED STATES PATENT AND TRADEMARK OFFICE - of first use of October 31, 2007 and a claimed date of first use in commerce of November 22, 2007.

Respondent J. Sergio Rios Gutierrez, an Individual (hereinafter, "Respondent"), whose address is 722 West 132nd Street, Gardena, CA 90247, is owner of the musical group "GRUPO LA MIGRA" as well as the stylized mark LA MIGRA plus design used in connection with goods, namely and audiovisual recordings, and services, namely live entertainment services of a musical group, which Respondent's musical group has used in its literal and stylized forms since at least as early as 1975 and in commerce since at least as early as 1976 (Proof and evidence attached). Respondent has filed an application with the United States Patent and Trademark Office to register the GRUPO LA MIGRA mark, Ser. No. 4,607,981, which "Published for Opposition" on May 7, 2013 (according to UNITED STATES PATENT & TRADEMARK OFFICE - publication), & was not opposed by Petitioner and/or any other parties.

The undersigned parties agree to enter discussions and negotiations in an attempt to resolve their dispute. In order to promote communication among the parties and the mediator and to facilitate settlement of the dispute, all parties agree as follows:

1. The parties consent to the appointment of Lorie Jones, a mediator for the California Academy of Mediation Professionals (CAMP), to act as mediator in this matter. CAMP is a non-profit organization funded by a grant from the Los Angeles County Dispute Resolution Program.

This means that, all communications, negotiations, or settlement discussions by and between participants in the course of this mediation shall remain confidential. No writings, evidence of anything said, or admission made for the purpose of, in the course of, or pursuant to this mediation is admissible or subject to discovery, and disclosure of the evidence shall not be compelled, in any arbitration, administrative adjudication, civil action, or other non criminal proceedings in which, pursuant to law, testimony can be compelled to be given.

However, each party further understands and acknowledges that evidence presented during this mediation may be verified outside of the mediation process and used as evidence in subsequent legal proceedings.

5. The mediator shall act as an advocate for the resolution of this dispute and shall use his/her best good faith efforts to assist the parties in reaching a mutually acceptable agreement. Each party agrees that the mediator and CAMP have no liability for any act or omission in connection with this mediation.
6. This Mediation/Confidentiality Agreement shall be admissible in any subsequent proceeding to prove the existence of the agreement and/or enforce said agreement.
7. The neutral person (mediator) has no conflict of interest in this case.
8. For certifiable low-income disputants and per contractor's fee policy, fees may not be assessed to certain disputants. If fees are charged, a copy of the sliding scale is available.
9. Disputants may elect to make their written settlement agreements enforceable or admissible at law.
10. Disputants may offer the testimony of witnesses.
11. Disputants may be represented by counsel during the proceedings, subject to the grantees policy and court rules governing such representation.

The mediator has the authority to terminate the dispute resolution proceeding if at any time he/she concludes that any disputant is uninformed or does not understand his/her rights or potential obligations; and it is the mediator's duty to encourage such a disputant to seek qualified legal, financial, or other professional advice.





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
