Petitioner, Orlando Sports Holdings, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, located and doing business at 618 E. South Street, Orlando, FL 32801 (“Petitioner”), believes that it is and will continue to be damaged by U.S. Reg. No. 3,894,425 for the mark FC GOLD PRIDE and U.S. Reg. No. 3,897,662 for the mark GOLD PRIDE (collectively “the Registrations”), both owned by Women’s Soccer, LLC¹, a Delaware limited liability company, located and doing business at 1750 Montgomery St, 1st Floor, San Francisco (“Registrant”), and thus hereby petitions to cancel the same.

¹ Note that TEAS and TSDR on USPTO.gov erroneously list a previous owner (i.e., Bay Area Women’s Soccer, LLC) as the owner of U.S. Reg. No.: 3,897,662 for GOLD PRIDE. U.S. Reg. No. 3,897,662 was assigned to Women’s Soccer, LLC on May 1, 2012 (Reel/Frame: 4770/0717) and correctively again on January 6, 2016 (Reel/Frame: 5716/0058).

Description of Registrations to be Cancelled:

Hereinafter the “Registrations.”

The grounds for Cancellation are as follows:

Abandonment

1. On information and belief, Registrant has taken affirmative steps to abandon the Registrations by discontinuing use of the GOLD PRIDE and FC GOLD PRIDE marks in the United States in connection with the goods listed in the Registrations with no intent to initiate or resume the use of the Registrations.

2. Prior to filing this Petition, Counsel for Petitioner visited the website *WomensProSoccer.com*, of which screenshots were submitted as specimens by Registrant in respective March 12, 2010 and September 3, 2010 Statements of Use, and discovered that any and all uses of the Registrations as trademarks have been removed.

3. By clicking the “About” tab on the above-referenced website (*WomensProSoccer.com*) Registrant learned that on Nov. 16, 2010 FC Gold Pride, the entity for which the Registrations were sought, closed operations. (see Exhibit A).

4. From further Internet searches for “Gold Pride” and “FC Gold Pride,” Registrant confirmed through an article in the *San Jose Mercury News* that on November 16, 2010 FC Gold Pride “folded after failing to find last-minute investors to save the two-year old enterprise.” (see Exhibit B).

5. From further Internet searches for “Gold Pride” and “FC Gold Pride,” Registrant confirmed through *SF Weekly* that FC Gold Pride “shut down operations effective immediately” on November 16, 2010 (see Exhibit C).

6. A December 9, 2010 post of the official Facebook page registered and managed FC Gold Pride stated that “if you are a season seat holder - refunds have all been processed.” (see Exhibit D).

7. A November 16, 2010 post on the above-referenced Facebook page stated that “with a heavy heart, FC Gold Pride closes operations.” (see Exhibit D).

8. From a review of the above-referenced Facebook page, it is clear that there has not been a single new post on the page since a post on December 17, 2010, which final post stated that any of Registrant’s items on sale on eBay “will expire tomorrow. Look for anything sold by FCGP2010, that is us.” (see Exhibit D).

9. When searching eBay on February 15, 2016 for any items sold by FCGP2010, Petitioner received the notification from eBay that “the seller User IDs you entered was not found,” thus indicating that this seller was no longer in use. (see Exhibit E).

10. Based on the above allegations, it is believed that the GOLD PRIDE and FC GOLD PRIDE marks identified in the Registrations have been abandoned within the meaning of the Trademark Act, 15 U.S.C. §1127.

11. Therefore, in view of Registrant’s discontinued use of the GOLD PRIDE and FC GOLD PRIDE marks identified in the Registrations, Registrant is not entitled to registration of the marks pursuant to the Trademark Act, 15 U.S.C. §1064(3), and as such, Registrant’s GOLD PRIDE and FC GOLD PRIDE Registrations should be cancelled.

Likelihood of Confusion

12. Petitioner has filed two pending U.S. trademark registration applications 86/801825, filed on October 28, 2015, and 86/780273, filed on October 7, 2015. (collectively “Applications”) (see Exhibits F & G).

13. Petitioner's pending Applications have been refused by the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office on the grounds of likelihood of confusion with Reg. Nos. 3,894,425 & 3,897,662 (the Registrations) owned by Registrant.

14. Petitioner has expended considerable effort and expense in pursuing its pending Applications and preparing its marks for use in commerce.

15. If Registrant is permitted to retain the Registrations sought to be cancelled, and thereby, the *prima facie* exclusive right to use in commerce the marks GOLD PRIDE and FC GOLD PRIDE, it is likely to prevent the registration of Petitioner's pending Applications based on the above-described U.S. Patent & Trademark Office refusal based on a likelihood of confusion in the marketplace within the meaning of 15 U.S.C. §1052(d).

16. In view of the above reasons, Registrant is not entitled to registration of the GOLD PRIDE and FC GOLD PRIDE marks, and as such, Registrant's GOLD PRIDE and FC GOLD PRIDE Registrations should be cancelled.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner has been and will be damaged by U.S. Reg. No. 3,894,425 for FC GOLD PRIDE and U.S. Reg. No. 3,897,662 for GOLD PRIDE, and Petitioner requests cancellation of the same.

WPS History

September 2003: Following the suspension of operations of the Women's United Soccer Association (WUSA), the WUSA Reorganization Committee is formed to determine the best method to re-launch a women's professional soccer league in the United States.

July 2004: The WUSA Reorganization Committee, the Women's Sports Foundation, and business executives Bob Greenberg and Chris Markgraf (both of whom go on to create WSII with Julie Foudy and Tonya Antonucci), hold a Summit in New York City to identify and examine the lessons learned from the WUSA's failure and to determine the best path forward toward the launch of a viable new league.

November 2004: As a result of the Summit, the not-for-profit Women's Soccer Initiative, Inc. (WSII) is formed with the support of the WUSA Players Association to promote and support all aspects of women's soccer in the United States chiefly by encouraging and enabling the creation of a world-class professional women's soccer league.

February 2005: The U.S. Soccer Federation and U.S. Soccer Foundation each provide operational grants to WSII to assist in supporting WSII's efforts to develop a viable business model and bring back women's professional soccer.

Feb. 27, 2007: WSII CEO Tonya Antonucci announces that AEG; John Hendricks of Freedom Soccer LLC; Jeff Cooper of St. Louis United Soccer LLC; Soccer Initiative, LLC; Jack Hanks and Brent Coralli of the Dallas Franchise Group and WGLSI, LLC have signed letters of intent to become charter members of the new women's professional league.

April 18, 2007: WSII CEO Tonya Antonucci announces that Sky Blue Soccer and Boston Women's Soccer LLC have agreed to join the previously announced groups as charter members of the new women's professional league.

Sept. 4, 2007: A new North American women's professional soccer league, under the temporary working title of Women's Soccer LLC, is formally established in the United States by seven investor groups, with play beginning in the spring of 2009. Initial teams will be based in Boston, Chicago, Dallas, Los Angeles, New Jersey/New York, St. Louis, and Washington D.C. Tonya Antonucci is named the league's commissioner. Soccer United Marketing (SUM), the commercial arm of MLS, is named the league's representative for national sponsorship sales and licensing.

Oct. 15, 2007: The League sets up offices in downtown San Francisco, Calif.

Jan. 17, 2008: The League's brand name, logo and website are launched at the National Soccer Coaches Association Convention in Baltimore, Md. Vicki Veenker is named General Counsel.

Feb. 5, 2008: Two-time NBA MVP Steve Nash and former Yahoo! President and Chief Operating Officer Jeff Mallett become investors and part owners of the league.

Feb. 15, 2008: WPS receives provisional Division 1 status at U.S. Soccer's Annual General Meeting (AGM). The league will receive full Division 1 status just prior to its inaugural season at the 2009 U.S. Soccer AGM in Orlando, Fla.

May 27, 2008: Philadelphia investors sign a letter of intent with the League regarding an expansion team for the 2010 season.

July 8, 2008: Women's Professional Soccer announces the post-Olympics timeline for National Team player allocation, drafts and team tryouts.

Aug. 11, 2008: Atlanta investors sign a letter of intent with the League regarding an expansion team for the 2010 season.

Sept. 3, 2008: A group of Bay Area investors join the League for the 2009 inaugural season. The League also announces that the team planned for Dallas is now slated to begin play in 2010 pending the securing of a stadium.

Sept. 16, 2008: In an announcement co-hosted by WPS Commissioner Tonya Antonucci and WPS Part-Owner and two-time NBA MVP Steve Nash in New York City, members of the U.S. Women's National Team player pool are allocated to WPS teams.

Sept. 24, 2008: Women's Professional Soccer (WPS) announced the results of its WPS Initial International Draft, officially assigning the WPS-playing rights of those selected by the individual teams.

Oct. 6, 2008: Women's Professional Soccer (WPS) and Fox Soccer Channel announced a multi-year partnership to televise a live national Sunday night WPS game of the week on America's premier soccer network beginning in 2009, the inaugural season for WPS.

Oct. 6, 2008: The WPS General Draft was conducted and consisted of four rounds of selections of international and domestic players for all seven WPS teams.

Dec. 15, 2008: Global sportlifestyle brand PUMA and Women's Professional Soccer (WPS) announced an exclusive partnership making PUMA an official founding partner of WPS and an official sponsor of all WPS franchises.

Dec. 16, 2008: Women's Professional Soccer (WPS) announced its opening game and slate of home openers for the inaugural 2009 WPS Season. Headlining the list of games is the "WPS Inaugural Match" featuring the Los Angeles Sol against the Washington Freedom at The Home Depot Center in Carson, CA.

Jan. 16, 2009: Women's Professional Soccer conducts its 2009 WPS Draft consisting of 10 rounds of selections of domestic and college players for all seven WPS teams.

Feb. 24, 2009: Women's Professional Soccer and PUMA unveil the 2009 home and away uniforms for all seven WPS teams at a fashion presentation

in New York City.

March 2, 2009: Preseason begins for all seven WPS teams.

March 29, 2009: The WPS Inaugural Match is held at The Home Depot Center in Carson, Calif. between the Los Angeles Sol and Washington Freedom.

May 18, 2009: WPS's eighth franchise is named Philadelphia Independence in a ceremony at the Franklin Institute.

June 18, 2009: WPS's ninth franchise is named the Atlanta Beat in a ceremony at Atlanta's Metro Chamber of Commerce.

Aug. 22, 2009: Sky Blue FC (NJ/NY) wins the inaugural WPS Championship, 1-0, over the Los Angeles Sol at The Home Depot Center in Carson, Calif.

Aug. 30, 2009: The WPS All-Stars defeat Umea IK, 4-2, in the WPS All-Star Game presented by the U.S. Coast Guard at The Anheuser-Busch Soccer Park in Fenton, Mo.

Jan. 15, 2010: Women's Professional Soccer conducts its 2010 WPS Draft with 65 college players being selected.

Jan. 28, 2010: Women's Professional Soccer discontinues operations of the Los Angeles Sol.

April 10, 2010: Women's Professional Soccer's second season kicks off.

May 27, 2010: The Saint Louis Athletica shut down their franchise.

Sept. 24, 2010: WPS announces a Western New York franchise as a 2011 expansion team.

Sept. 26, 2010: FC Gold Pride wins the 2010 WPS Championship with a 4-0 victory over the Philadelphia Independence at Pioneer Stadium in Hayward, Calif.

Oct. 1, 2010: Tonya Antonucci steps down as WPS Commissioner and Anne-Marie Eileraas assumes the role of Chief Executive Officer.

Nov. 16, 2010: FC Gold Pride closes operations.

Dec. 1, 2010: The Western New York Flash, a 2011 expansion team, unveil its team name and logo.

Dec. 13, 2010: Chicago Red Stars announce the team will forego the 2011 season.

Jan. 14, 2011: Women's Professional Soccer conducts its 2011 WPS Draft consisting of four rounds of selections that saw 24 players selected by the six participating teams.

March 2, 2011: Preseason officially opens for all six teams.

April 9, 2011: Atlanta Beat and Boston Breakers kick off Women's Professional Soccer's third season in the opening match of 2011 at KSU Soccer Stadium in Kennesaw, GA.

Aug. 14, 2011: Western New York Flash clinch the 2011 Regular Season Championship, an automatic berth into the WPS Championship match and the right to host the Final at their home stadium.

Aug. 27, 2011: Western New York Flash cap the club's inaugural season in WPS by capturing the 2011 WPS Championship in front of a record-setting Championship crowd of 10,461.

Sept. 18, 2011: Anne Marie Eileraas steps down as Chief Executive Officer of WPS.

Sept. 26, 2011: Jennifer O'Sullivan is appointed Chief Executive Officer of WPS.

FC Gold Pride was an American professional soccer club based in Santa Clara, California which participated in Women's Professional Soccer. The club replaced the San Jose CyberRays of the defunct Women's United Soccer Association as the top-level women's soccer team in the San Francisco Bay Area. FC Gold Pride moved to its final home of Pioneer Stadium on the campus of CSU East Bay in June 2010 after opening their 2010 home schedule at the Castro Valley High School Athletic Stadium. The club ceased operations in November 2010 after struggling financially and being unable to find new investors.^[2]



Team history

Founding

FC Gold Pride was founded on 3 September 2008 as the seventh and final team to join the new top tier Women's Professional Soccer league. The team is owned by a group led by Brian and Nancy NeSmith, the former being the CEO of Sunnyvale-based internet technology company Blue Coat Systems.^[3] Former San Jose Clash midfielder and local youth coach Albertin Montoya was named the team's first head coach, while former CyberRays and Brazilian National Team player Sissi was announced as the first assistant coach for FC Gold Pride on 29 September 2008.^[4]

On 13 November 2008, the team's home venue was revealed to be Buck Shaw Stadium in Santa Clara, which it shares with San Jose Earthquakes of Major League Soccer as well as the Santa Clara University soccer teams. The team revealed its official name and logo (FC Gold Pride) to the public for the first time on 19 November 2008.

On 16 September 2008, the initial WPS player allocation was conducted, which consisted of U.S. Women's National Team players. Nicole Barnhart, Leslie Osborne and Rachel Buehler were allocated to FC Gold Pride.^[5] On 24 September 2008, a further four players were allocated to the Bay Area via the 2008 WPS International Draft. The allocated players were strikers Christine Sinclair (Canada) and Eriko Arakawa (Japan), along with two Brazilians, midfielder Formiga and defender Érika. The Pride signed a one-year deal with Formiga in February 2009,^[6] as well as Arakawa, post-draft discovery pick Adriane (Brazil),^[7] Érika, and Sinclair.^[8]

At the 2009 WPS Draft, FC Gold Pride drafted three former college stars: UCLA midfielder Christina DiMartino, Notre Dame defender Carrie Dew, and Penn State forward Tiffany Weimer. Also amongst the 2009 draftees was former United States national team star Brandi Chastain.

2009 WPS season

FC Gold Pride won their inaugural WPS game against the Boston Breakers on April 5, 2009.^[9] The club remained in strong contention until defender Kandace Wilson was injured during a home game against the Los Angeles Sol. After that, FC Gold Pride's second loss at the hands of the Washington Freedom marked the beginning of the club's slide to the bottom of the WPS rankings, where it would remain for the rest of the season. The club's transactions in the wake of Wilson's injury included signing Los Angeles Sol draftee Greer Barnes, elevating developmental player Marisa Abegg to the full roster, and returning Sissi to the field as a player.

In the end, FC Gold Pride failed to make the 2009 Women's Professional Soccer Playoffs, after a must-win game against the Saint Louis Athletica ended in a 1–1 draw.^[10] The club finally snapped its ten-game winless streak with a final 3–2 win against the Washington Freedom on August 1, 2009.^[11] However, a last loss to Sky Blue FC and a tie with Saint Louis Athletica did not allow FC Gold Pride to avoid finishing last in the WPS standings.

2009–2010 Off-season moves

The only player FC Gold Pride lost to the 2009 WPS Expansion Draft was defender Leigh Ann Robinson, chosen by the Atlanta Beat.^[12] Over the course of the offseason, the club traded Allison Whitworth to the Atlanta Beat, and released several players, including team captain Leslie Osborne, leading assist-getter Tiffany Weimer, Eriko Arakawa, Formiga, and Brandi Chastain. Osborne and Weimer would later join the Boston Breakers, and Formiga was taken by the Chicago Red Stars. The club signed Niki Cross (later to rejoin her first WPS club, Saint Louis Athletica), and Candace Chapman.^[13] After scouting the 2009 UEFA Women's Championship, the club signed Norwegian international Solveig Gulbrandsen.^[14]

In what was considered a major coup, FC Gold Pride signed Los Angeles Sol player Camille Abily, trading midfielder Christina DiMartino, FC Gold Pride's top 2009 WPS Draft pick, to Los Angeles.^[15] The club also had a successful 2010 WPS Draft, drafting 2009 Hermann Trophy winner Kelley O'Hara, New Zealand international Ali Riley, and 2008 U-20 World Cup champions Becky Edwards and Kaley Fountain,

among others.^[16]

The Los Angeles Sol ceased operations not long afterwards; in the ensuing 2010 WPS Dispersal Draft, FC Gold Pride acquired Marta, Kiki Bosio, and Lindsay Browne.^[17] Another Los Angeles Sol player, Brittany Cameron, was also signed separately as a free agent.^[18]

2010 Season

FC Gold Pride started fast and kept its momentum running throughout the 2010 season. Despite the departure of Solveig Gulbrandsen and trading Kaley Fountain to the Atlanta Beat, the Pride dominated the league's regular season and on September 26, 2010, won their first WPS Championship by defeating the Philadelphia Independence, 4–0.^[19] Three members of the team garnered end of season honors: Marta was named Player of the Year and won the Golden Boot, both for the second consecutive season; Nicole Barnhart was named Goalkeeper of the Year; and Ali Riley was named Rookie of the Year. After the close of the 2010 season it was revealed on November 16, 2010 that FC Gold Pride had folded and would not be returning for the 2011 season.^{[20][21]}

F.C. Gold Pride, Women's Soccer Champs, Abruptly Disband

The world champion F.C. Gold Pride soccer team has gone from kicking balls to kicking the bucket in a matter of a few short weeks.

After handily capturing the Women's Professional Soccer league title with a 4-0 win in the title game in late September, F.C. Gold Pride today released a jarring e-mail announcing they will "shut down operations

effective immediately."

Based on another communique from the league's San Francisco-based office, it seems the Hayward franchise did not meet the league's "reserve funding requirement."

Your humble narrator **attended the Gold Pride's inaugural press conference in 2008**. As we wrote at the time, the WPS seemed a likely candidate to join the alphabet soup of failed pro soccer leagues littering the graveyard of American sports -- and it brings us no joy to have made the safe and predictable call.

The league, in fact, continues, as teams from Atlanta, Boston, New Jersey, Philadelphia, Washington, and Western New York *did* have enough money in the bank to keep WPS officials from kicking out the plug. But the life-support metaphor is apt.

This year, the league's runaway champs are kaput. Last year, the regular season's winningest franchise, Los Angeles, was contracted. Both teams featured **Marta**, the premier women's soccer player on God's green earth (in fact, L.A.'s demise paved the way for the Bay Area franchise to land her).

If you can't support teams featuring the world's best players and bringing home championship trophies, what'll it take? Let us know when you find out. Let the WPS know, too.
