**PETITIONER BARRIO FIESTA MANUFACTURING CORPORATION’S REQUEST
FOR JUDICIAL NOTICE IN SUPPORT OF MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

Petitioner Barrio Fiesta Manufacturing Corporation (“BFMC”) requests that the Board take judicial notice of the following matters and documents, pursuant to Rule 201 of the Federal Rules of Evidence. To the extent that documents were authenticated in depositions, those documents are attached as exhibits to the Declaration of Melvin N.A. Avanzado (the “Avanzado Declaration”) filed concurrently herewith.^{1/} To the extent that the documents are public records, those documents are attached as direct exhibits to this request for judicial notice.

1. The Avanzado Declaration submitted herewith attaches the Declarations of Erlinda Alianan (Exhibit 1), Ronald Yu (Exhibit 2) and Melvin N.A. Avanzado (Exhibit 3) which were filed in the lawsuit pending between BFMC’s United States distributor and Registrant June Francis Rono’s company entitled *Barrio Fiesta, LLC v. Northridge Foods International, Inc.*, United States District Court for the Northern District of California, Case Number 4:15-cv-02669 (the “Federal Lawsuit”). References to the exhibits in these Federal Lawsuit declarations shall be referenced by the declaration’s exhibit number to the Avanzado Declaration filed herewith followed by the exhibit number to the corresponding declaration filed in the Federal Lawsuit. For example, the Avanzado Declaration filed in the Federal Lawsuit is Exhibit 3 to the declaration submitted here; thus, Exhibit A of the Avanzado Declaration filed in the Federal Lawsuit is cited herein as “Avanzado Ex. 3-A.”

A. On September 14, 2010, Registrant June Francis Rono (“June”) filed for incorporation and registration of Barrio Fiesta, LLC (“BFFLC”) as a California limited liability company with the Secretary of State of the State of California. Attached hereto as Exhibit “1” is a true and correct copy of the Business Entity detail for BFFLC on the website of the California Secretary of State.

B. Barrio Fiesta Restaurant Incorporated formally filed for registration in the Philippines in 1977. Attached hereto as Exhibit “2” is a true and correct copy of Barrio Fiesta Restaurant Incorporated’s articles of incorporation that were formally filed with the Philippines Securities and Exchange Commission (“Philippines SEC”) in 1977.

C. On February 15, 2011, Registrants Ashley Kirsten C. Rono (“Ashley”) and Justin Christian C. Rono (“Justin”) filed trademark application serial number 85/243,004 (the “‘004 Application”) with the United States Patent and Trademark Office (“USPTO”) for registration of the mark “Barrio Fiesta Express” in the fast-food restaurant classification. The ‘004 Application lists the date of first use of the “Barrio Fiesta Express” mark as January 3, 2011. The ‘004 Application was introduced and authenticated during June’s May 12, 2016 deposition as Exhibit 58 to that deposition. The true and correct copy of the ‘004 Application that was introduced and authenticated during that deposition is attached as Exhibit “3-JJ” to the Avanzado Declaration.

D. The “Barrio Fiesta Express” mark became a registered trademark on October 4, 2011. The USPTO issued a certificate for trademark registration number 4,034,365 (the “‘365 Registration”) on October 4, 2011 to Ashley and Justin for the “Barrio Fiesta Express” mark for use in fast-food restaurants (later “corrected” on January 6, 2015 to include June Francis Rono as an additional owner). A true and correct copy of the original ‘365 Registration from the USPTO is attached hereto as Exhibit “3”.

E. On December 8, 2014, Ashley and Justin filed the trademark assignment of the entire interest and goodwill in “Barrio Fiesta Express” to June, Ashley and Justin (collectively “Registrants”) as joint owners with the USPTO. This December 8, 2014 trademark

assignment was introduced and authenticated during the January 6, 2016 deposition of Ashley as Exhibit 19 to that deposition. A true and correct copy of this trademark assignment is attached as Exhibit “**3-P**” to the Avanzado Declaration.

F. Registrants currently own the “Barrio Fiesta Express” mark as reflected in an updated ‘365 Registration pursuant to the December 8, 2014 trademark assignment. This “corrected” ‘365 Registration certificate was introduced and authenticated during the January 6, 2016 deposition of Ashley Kirsten C. Rono as Exhibit 18 to that deposition. A true and correct copy of this October 4, 2011 certificate is attached as Exhibit “**3-O**” to the Avanzado Declaration.

G. BFMC filed its by-laws and articles of incorporation with the Republic of the Philippines SEC in December 1987. BFMC’s registered by-laws and articles of incorporation were introduced and authenticated during the April 18, 2016 deposition of Bonifacio E. Ongpauco, Jr. (“Bonifacio”) as Exhibit 37 and Exhibit 38 to that deposition. A true and correct copy of BFMC’s registered by-laws is attached to the Avanzado Declaration as Exhibit “**3-T**.” A true and correct copy of BFMC’s registered articles of incorporation is attached to the Avanzado Declaration as Exhibit “**3-U**.”

H. Bonifacio filed or caused to be filed with the State of California and the USPTO documents in connection with BFMC’s exportation and distribution of Barrio Fiesta products in the United States. Defendant requests judicial notice of the following documents:

1. Bonifacio filed an application to register the “Barrio Fiesta” trademark in connection with BFMC’s packaged food products on November 25, 1992 with the Secretary of State of the State of California. This application was given registration number 097662. Attached as Exhibit “**4**” hereto is a true and correct certified copy of Bonifacio’s California trademark registration application for “Barrio Fiesta.”

2. Bonifacio registered the “Barrio Fiesta” trademark in connection with food products with the State of California Office of the Secretary of State on June 14, 1993. Bonifacio’s trademark registration was given registration number 097662.

This document was introduced and authenticated as deposition Exhibit 45 during Bonifacio's April 18, 2016 deposition. A true and correct copy of the certificate of registration of trademark for registration number 097662 is attached as Exhibit "**3-BB**" to the Avanzado Declaration.

3. Bonifacio attempted to register the "Barrio Fiesta" mark and logo with the USPTO on May 18, 2006 in connection with packaged food products. Bonifacio filed trademark application serial number 78/886,373 with the USPTO on May 18, 2006 for the "Barrio Fiesta" mark and logo in connection with packaged food products (the "'373 Application"). The '373 Application specifies the first use of the "Barrio Fiesta" mark in commerce as December 10, 1987. The '373 Application was introduced and authenticated during Bonifacio's April 18, 2016 deposition as Exhibit 46 to that deposition. A true and correct copy of the '373 Application is attached as Exhibit "**3-CC**" to the Avanzado Declaration.

4. BFMC attempted to register the "Barrio Fiesta" mark and logo with the USPTO on May 11, 2007 in connection with packaged food products. BFMC filed trademark application serial number 77/179,318 with the USPTO on May 11, 2007 for the "Barrio Fiesta" mark and logo in connection with packaged food products (the "'318 Application"). The '318 Application specifies that the "Barrio Fiesta" mark was first used in commerce as early as December 10, 1987. The '318 Application was introduced and authenticated during Bonifacio's April 18, 2016 deposition as Exhibit 47 to that deposition. A true and correct copy of the '318 Application is attached as Exhibit "**3-DD**" to the Avanzado Declaration.

I. Documents in connection with the Ongpauco siblings' operation of various Barrio Fiesta restaurants in the Los Angeles area were filed with the State of California.

1. The Manila Restaurant, Inc. filed an application with the California Secretary of State to register the service mark and logo "Barrio Fiesta" in connection with restaurant services for the Barrio Fiesta restaurant on Sixth Street in Los Angeles,

California (the “Los Angeles BF Restaurant”) on October 1, 1986. The application specifies the “Barrio Fiesta” mark was first used anywhere in commerce as 1958 and first used in commerce in California as December 4, 1985. This application was given the service mark registration number 28689. This application was introduced and authenticated during the April 20, 2016 deposition of Cesar Cauton (“Cauton”) as Exhibit 52. A true and correct copy of the application for service mark registration number 28689 is attached as Exhibit “**3-FF**” to the Avanzado Declaration.

2. The Manila Restaurant, Inc. obtained a registration for the “Barrio Fiesta” service mark – service mark registration number 28689 – from the State of California on October 29, 1986. This certificate of registration specifies that the “Barrio Fiesta” mark was first used anywhere in 1958 and first used in California on December 4, 1985. This certificate of registration for service mark registration number 28689 was introduced and authenticated during Cauton’s April 20, 2016 deposition as Exhibit 51. A true and correct copy of the certificate of registration for service mark registration number 28689 is attached as Exhibit “**3-EE**” to the Avanzado Declaration.

3. The Manila Restaurant, Inc. assigned its registered service mark “Barrio Fiesta” (service mark registration number 28689) to Manuel Tamayo, Corazon Ongpauco-Tamayo and Sixta Evangelista on April 23, 1990. This assignment was filed with the Secretary of State of the State of California. This assignment was introduced and authenticated during Cauton’s deposition as Exhibit 52. A true and correct copy of the assignment for service mark registration number 28689 is attached as Exhibit “**3-FF**” to the Avanzado Declaration.

4. Consuelo Ongpauco-Cauton (“Ongpauco-Cauton”) obtained a registration for the service mark “The Original Barrio Fiesta of Manila” – service mark registration number 055400 – in connection with restaurant services with the State of California Secretary of State on October 3, 2001. Ongpauco-Cauton’s application specifies that the first use of “The Original Barrio Fiesta” mark in commerce in

California was in 1987 and first used anywhere in commerce in 1959. This registration was introduced and authenticated during Cauton's deposition as Exhibit 53. A true and correct copy of the registration for service mark registration number 055400 is attached as Exhibit "**3-GG**" to the Avanzado Declaration.

5. Ongpauco-Cauton renewed registration for the service mark "The Original Barrio Fiesta of Manila" – service mark number 055400 –on May 26, 2011 with the State of California Secretary of State. This renewal was introduced and authenticated during Cauton's deposition as Exhibit 54. A true and correct copy of the renewal for service mark registration number 055400 is attached as Exhibit "**3-HH**" to the Avanzado Declaration.

6. Ongpauco-Cauton petitioned to cancel the federal registration of the mark "The Original Barrio Fiesta of Manila" held by Barrio Fiesta International, Inc. – registration number 1,712,454 – with the USPTO on July 9, 2013. Barrio Fiesta International, Inc. used "The Original Barrio Fiesta of Manila" mark in connection with restaurant services. Ongpauco-Cauton sought to cancel registration number 1,712,454 on abandonment grounds. This cancellation petition was introduced and authenticated during Cauton's deposition as Exhibit 55. A true and correct copy of the cancellation petition is attached as Exhibit "**3-II**" to the Avanzado Declaration.

7. The USPTO cancelled "The Original Barrio Fiesta of Manila" mark held by Barrio Fiesta International, Inc. on September 18, 2015. Attached hereto as Exhibit "**4**" is a true and correct copy of the USPTO's cancellation of "The Original Barrio Fiesta of Manila" mark formerly held by Barrio Fiesta International, Inc.

J. Facts and documents relating to BFMC's current application for registration of a "Barrio Fiesta" mark. On or about February 9, 2015, BFMC filed with the USPTO a trademark registration application Serial No. 86/528,183 (the "'183 Application") for a "Barrio Fiesta" mark in various classifications. Attached hereto as Exhibit "**5**" is a true and correct copy of the '183 Application. On or about November 28, 2015, the USPTO suspended

the '183 Application due to likelihood of confusion with Registrants' '365 Mark. Attached hereto as Exhibit "6" is a true and correct copy of the USPTO's suspension letter.

Judicial notice is appropriate for facts "not subject to reasonable dispute ... that [are] ... capable of accurate and ready determination by resort to sources whose accuracy cannot reasonably be questioned." Fed. R. Evid. 201(c). All of the documents and information listed above are contained in the files of the United States Patent and Trademark Office, in the files of the office of the California Secretary of State or in the public records of Philippines SEC. The facts and events in such documents – the public records of the USPTO, the offices of the California Secretary of State and the Philippines SEC which Northridge submits herewith and in exhibits to the Avanzado Declaration – are matters which are "capable of accurate and ready determination by resort to sources whose accuracy cannot reasonably be questioned."

Accordingly, this request for judicial notice should be granted.

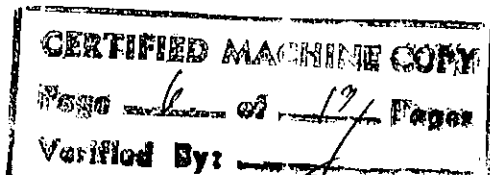

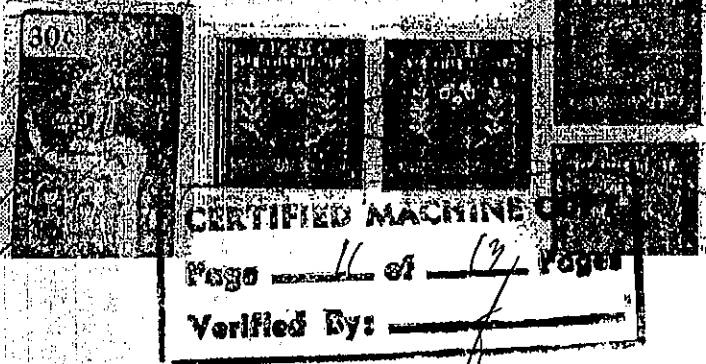

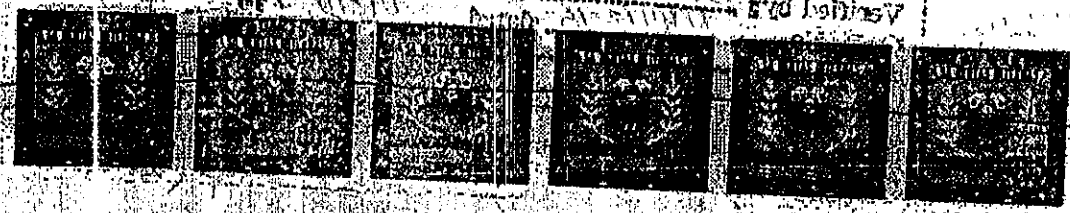
