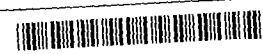


This is Warner Lambert's first request for an extension of time to file a Notice of Opposition against the above-identified application. This additional time is req


