Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. §2.19(b), Jeffrey I.D. Lewis, hereby requests permission to withdraw as attorney herein.


On July 14, 2000 a letter was sent to Kenneth Blum, Manager of Applicant advising that the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office issued an office action suspending the captioned application pending the disposition of application Serial No. 74/546,967. On August 20, 2000 a facsimile was sent to Mr. Blum requesting confirmation of our letter of July 14, 2000, as part of this firm's withdrawal as counsel to Applicant. To date, we have had no contact or correspondence from Mr. Blum or on behalf of Applicant since that time until we contacted Mr. Blum today in response to the Official Correspondence. Our file has been closed on this matter since August 2000, when all matters were transferred back to 1899 Limited LC.

On October 8, 2002 I received a Request for Extension of Time to File a Notice of Opposition under 37 C.F.R. §2.102 (copy enclosed).
