REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO OPPOSE

Pursuant to Trademark Rule 2.102, the American Water Resources Association, Potential Opposer herein, through its authorized attorney, requests that it be granted a thirty (30) day extension of time within which to file an opposition against American Water Works Company, Inc. regarding the mark American Water Resources (application filed on January 12, 2000). This mark was published in the Official Gazette of the United States Patent and Trademark Office on December 31, 2002 as Serial Number 75/895,974, in Classes 11, 37, 40 and 42 for water and waste water treatment devices, namely water purifying units, water filtration units, water softeners and hardeners, radiation emitters, water and waste water treatment units for measuring, extracting, diminishing, or physically or chemically altering wastes, gases and other impurities in water and wastewater, water and waste water treatment units for transporting, storing and moving water and wastewater through pipes, tanks containers, vessels and other media and substances; construction of water and waste water treatment plants; design and engineering of water and waste treatment plants; consulting services related to the regulatory technical and financial aspects of water and waste water treatment providing information in the field of water and waste water treatment by means of a global computer network laboratory and research services in the field of water quality and treatment; water and waste water treatment. The opposition period expires on January 30, 2003, and potential opposer requests that a thirty day (30) day extension be granted, extending the deadline to March 1, 2003.




