The request for a 60-day extension of time to oppose filed July 1, 2002 on behalf of Commerce One Operations, Inc. is noted.

Trademark Rule 2.102(c), as amended effective February 27, 1983, provides that ". . . A first extension of time for not more than thirty days will be granted upon request. Further extensions of time may be granted by the Board for good cause. . . ." (emphasis added)

However, since it is indicated that applicant consented to the request, the Board will construe the consent as good cause.

Accordingly, the request is granted. Commerce One Operations, Inc. is allowed until September 1, 2002 in which to file an opposition to the registration sought by applicant.

However, potential opposer is advised that no further extensions of time will be approved on that merit; and that any further request should also include a recitation of circumstances constituting good cause for the extension requested.
