STIPULATED REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME  
TO FILE A NOTICE OF OPPOSITION

InforMax, Inc. ("Opposer"), located at 7600 Wisconsin Avenue, Suite #1100, Bethesda, Maryland 20814, through its undersigned attorneys, respectfully requests that it be granted an additional sixty-one (61) day extension of time, to and including March 21, 2002, within which to file a Notice of Opposition to registration of the mark INFORMIX (Stylized), U.S. Application Serial No. 76/081,486, filed June 30, 2000, owned by Informix Software, Inc. ("Applicant") and published for opposition in the Official Gazette on April 24, 2001. The period for the filing of an Opposition presently is set to expire on January 19, 2002. Counsel for Applicant, Karin Segall, has consented to the requested extension.

The additional time is requested for the purpose of allowing Opposer to consider, and the parties to discuss, a recent settlement proposal presented by Applicant relating to this matter as well as Opposition No. 129,995. Opposer and Applicant are parties to Opposition No. 120,995, which involves Opposer's application to register the mark INFORMAX, U.S. Application Serial No. 75/891,644. Opposition No. 120,995 has been suspended until March 21, 2002 to allow the parties to engage in settlement negotiations. Now, therefore, Opposer respectfully requests that the requested extension be granted so that the parties may continue discussions with a view towards reaching an agreement to resolve this matter as well as Opposition No. 129,995.
