

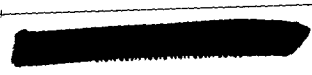

**SECOND REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF


