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In a February 14, 2003 mailing, the TTAB requested that the Potential Opposer explain the progress made by the parties in efforts to resolve the matter. After recent discussions between the parties' counsels, the parties have agreed in principle to the terms of a Consent Agreement that would avoid an opposition. 
