John Kelly, counsel for the Applicant, agreed to this extension request in a telephone conversation on October 7, 2002.






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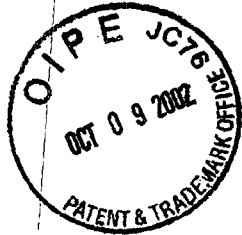
