Sir:

The Chancellors and Masters of the University of Oxford (the "University of Oxford"), an entity incorporated by royal charter in 1357, and subsequently by the Oxford & Cambridge Act of 1571 in the United Kingdom having its principal place of business at Great Clarendon Street Oxford OX2 6DP UNITED KINGDOM, by and through its attorneys, Satterlee Stephens Burke & Burke LLP, hereby requests that the Board grant an additional sixty (60) day extension of time to file a Notice of Opposition in the above-identified matter.

The Applicant, Fame Information Services, Inc. ("Fame") agreed to this extension on April 14, 2003.

Please note that the settlement of this matter is complicated by the fact that it involves three parties working together towards settlement: Princeton University, which has a pending opposition proceeding against this application, Fame and the University of Oxford. Nonetheless, the parties have made progress towards the settlement of this matter. The parties have exchanged numerous e-mails in connection with their negotiations since the last request for an extension of time, specifically, on the following dates: 2/18/03, 3/17/03, 3/20/03, 3/24/03. In March, the University of Oxford sent a proposed draft settlement agreement to Fame for its review. Recently, the University of Oxford had a telephone conference with counsel for Fame on March 27, 2003. Currently, the University of Oxford is awaiting Fame's comments on its new proposed draft settlement agreement.

This Request is being submitted in triplicate as required by 37 C.F.R. § 2.102(d).
