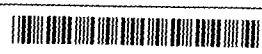

Now comes Johnson & Johnson, a New Jersey corporation, having an address at One Johnson & Johnson Plaza, New Brunswick, New Jersey 08933-7001, and requests an additional extension of thirty (30) days beyond March 20, 2003, or until **Monday, April 21, 2003**, within which to oppose the above captioned application.

Contrary to the Board's February 24, 2003 order closing the opposition period on March 19, 2003, Johnson & Johnson respectfully submits that since February 17, 2003 was a federal holiday, the calculation for the fifth extension of time to oppose should have begun on February 18, 2003; thirty days from that date is March 20, 2003.
