In a letter dated June 1, 2004, the Board denied potential opposer's request for extension of time to oppose filed May 28, 2004 because the request was not timely filed.

On June 2, 2004, potential opposer filed a copy of a request for an extension of time; a cover letter with a certificate of mailing dated March 24, 2004 and a copy of the return receipt card. The cover letter with a certificate of mailing was apparently lost in the mail. The request filed June 2, 2004 (with a certificate of mailing dated March 24, 2004) was timely filed and potential opposer would have been allowed until May 26, 2004 to file an opposition.

Accordingly, the Board's action denying the request for an extension filed May 28, 2004 is vacated, said request is granted and potential opposer is now allowed until **June 10, 2004** in which to file an opposition to the registration sought by applicant.
