The proposed amendment filed by applicant on March 12, 2003, is noted.

In connection with the foregoing, it should be noted that pursuant to a request for extension of time granted February 4, 2003, the potential opposer herein, MGA Entertainment, Inc., was allowed until January 11, 2003, in which to file an opposition to this application.
