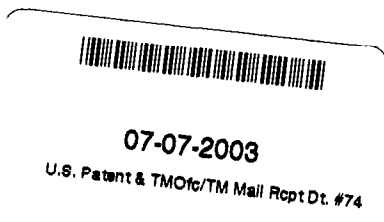


REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO OPPOSE


Applicant's counsel has agreed to the granting of this extension.
