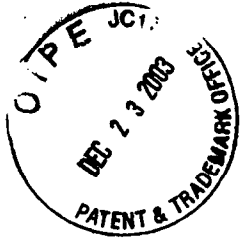



In response to the Examining Attorney's second Office Action, kindly amend the identification of goods and services in the above application to the following:

--Class 10: "Artificial limbs; sutures; abdominal and orthopedic belts; orthopedic supports; compression bandages; air mattresses for medical purposes; anesthetic masks; artificial teeth; orthodontic appliances; dentures; autoclaves for medical use; baby bottles; containers for medical waste; defibrillators; aerosol dispensers for medical use; disposable medical sterilization pouches; dropper bottles for administering medication, sold empty; medical bags designed to hold medical instruments sold empty; paper envelopes and bags for sterilizing medical instruments; cases fitted for medical instruments for use by doctors; medical ice packs; hearing aids; masks for use by medical personnel; medical syringes; ocular implants; photographs

for medical purposes, namely, x-rays; air pillows for medical purposes; arm and leg prostheses; respirators for artificial respiration; scalpels; sterilization units for medical instruments; blood filters; transdermal drug delivery patches sold without medication; transfusion sets; drainage tubes for medical purposes; stethoscopes; surgical blades, caps, clips, compresses, scissors, saws; surgical implants comprising artificial material; exercise machines for therapeutic purposes; traction apparatus for medical use; ultrasonic medical diagnostic apparatus; ultrasound diagnostic apparatus; x-ray apparatus for medical use; anesthetic delivery apparatus; apparatus for artificial respiration; blood pressure measuring apparatus; electric and non-electric massage apparatus; obstetric apparatus for cattle; phototherapeutic apparatus for medical purposes; medical treatment apparel; pulse rate monitors; respiration monitors; operating room apparel; operating tables; patient treatment tables; external fixators for orthopedic surgery, body cavity drains, bags and pouches; endotracheal tubes; tracheotomy tubes; surgical bandages, plaster casts of Paris for orthopedic purposes, cannulae, hypodermic needles, spinal needles for medical use, condoms, surgical drapes, examination and surgical gloves; tongue depressors; crutches; oxygen delivery apparatus, namely, hyperbaric oxygen chambers for medical purposes, oxygen concentrators for medical applications, oxygen masks for medical use and oxygen monitors; tourniquets; blood transfusion bags,

filters and equipment; ophthalmoscopes, otoscopes, medical thermometers; surgical operating lamps; surgical gowns; medical gowns; patient examination gowns; emergency medical kits comprised of first aid and surgical components for hospital and pre-hospital care, and snake bite kits; electric blankets for medical purposes";

--Class 12: "Aerostats; airplanes and structural parts therefor; amphibious airplanes; dirigibles; helicopters and structural parts therefor; all-terrain vehicles; ambulances and structural parts therefor; automatic guided vehicles; automobiles and structural parts therefor; motor homes; bicycles; motorcycles and structural parts therefor; tractors; trucks and structural parts therefor; vans and structural parts therefor; buses and structural parts therefor; ferry boats; boats and structural parts therefor; rafts; ships; yachts; wagons; locomotives; funicular railcars";

--Class 16: "Posters; cards, namely, cards not magnetically coded for use in food and goods distribution, greeting cards, business cards, visitor cards, medical identification cards, announcement cards; agendas; calendars; cardboard cartons; printed and paper emblems; envelopes for packaging; printed forms; non-textile paper printed labels; newsprint paper; newspaper for general circulation; notebooks; personal organizers; law digests; law reports; architectural plans and specifications; atlases; presentation boards; bulletin

boards; writing paper; paper flags; publication papers; educational publications, namely teaching and training manuals, newspapers and books in the field of international humanitarian law, medicine, veterinary care and sanitation methods, agricultural methods and hospital administration; paper identification tags; paper teaching materials in the field of international humanitarian law, medicine, veterinary care and sanitation methods, agricultural methods, hospital administration; photographs; adhesives for stationery; plastic or paper bags for merchandise packaging; paper envelopes for packaging; paper for wrapping and packaging; paper pouches for packaging; plastic bubble packs for wrapping or packaging";

--Class 22: "Tents, canvas canopies; canvas tarpaulins; eiderdown covers, duvet covers; postal bags; canvas bags for storage of food; mesh bags for storage; plastic bags for securing valuables; polyethylene bags; sacks or bags for the transportation or storage of material in bulk; textile bags for merchandise packaging; multipurpose cloth bags; body bags; ropes";

--Class 24: "Cloth flags; cloth labels; bed blankets; mosquito nets; textile used as lining for clothing";

--Class 25: "Blouses, bonnets; boots; chemises; coats; footwear; gloves; jackets; jeans; maillots; pantaloons; parkas; polo shirts; pullovers; socks; shirts; skirts; suits; sweat

shirts; T-shirt; sweaters; thermal underwear; trousers; tunics; underclothes; vests”;

--Class 35: “Accounting services; direct mail advertising; preparing advertisements for others; business consultation and business management consultation; personnel recruitment; consultation in the field of employment hiring, recruiting, placement, staffing and career networking services; business planning; office functions, namely, providing facilities for the use of office equipment and machinery, and for business meetings; rental of office machinery and equipment; data processing services; document reproductions; dissemination of advertising matter; administration of cultural and exchange programs; hospital management; providing web sites featuring information in the field of hospital management; health care utilization and review services; business investigations; mail sorting, handling and receiving; mailing list preparation; medical cost management; medical transcription services; outsourcing services for other in the field of international humanitarian law, medicine, veterinary care and sanitation methods, agricultural methods, and hospital administration; telephone answering services; message transcription services; public relations; procurement, namely purchasing food and first aid goods and first aid and medical services for others; charitable services, namely, supplying medicines to need persons and to underdeveloped countries”;

--Class 38: "Telecommunications services, namely, local and long distance transmission of voice, data, graphics by mean of telephone, telegraphic, cable, wireless and satellite transmissions; electronic store-and-forward messaging; telephone voice messaging services; web messaging; wireless digital and analog messaging; delivery of messages by electronic transmission; television and video broadcasting; video teleconferencing; providing multiple user access to a global computer information network; providing a high speed access to area network and a global computer information network; communications services, namely transmitting sound and audio-visual recording via the Internet";

--Class 39: "Transportation of passengers and goods by air, boat, rail, bus, car; ambulance transport; packaging articles for transportation; postal services, namely, parcel delivery, delivery of food and goods by truck, air, boats, train and bus; document delivery by non electronic means; correspondence delivery by post and messenger; storage of food; storage of non-food goods, namely, medical and surgical instruments and first aid materials; warehouse storage; delivery of newspapers; distribution and transmission of water and energy; electronic storage of messages and data; rescue services, providing professional information and consultation services in the field of transportation, namely information and consultation in the field of human and goods transportation; charitable

services, namely, providing transportation for the elderly and handicapped persons”;

--Class 41: “Educational services, namely, conducting workshops and providing courses of instruction at primary, secondary, and college levels in the fields of international law, humanitarian law, medicine, hospital administration and architecture, agricultural method, veterinary care, sanitation methods, and distributing course materials in connection therewith; arranging and conducting educational congresses, seminars, symposium, colloquium and conferences; charitable services, namely, providing training in the fields of international law, humanitarian law, medicine, hospital administration, architecture, agricultural methods, veterinary care and sanitation methods; entertainment in the nature of theater productions; motion picture film production; multimedia entertainment software production services; music production services; production and distribution of motion pictures, production of video cassettes and discs; radio entertainment production; itinerant library services; entertainment in the nature of visual and audio performances, namely, live musical bands, as well as gymnastic, dance, opera and ballet performances; entertainment services, namely providing a web site featuring musical performances, musical videos, related film clips, photographs and other multimedia materials; entertainment services, namely, providing radio and television programs in the



field of variety, news, international and humanitarian law, medicine, hospital administration and architecture, agricultural methods, veterinary care and sanitation methods via a global computer network or distributed over television satellite, audio, and video medias; organizing community and charity festivals and exhibitions featuring sporting events, art exhibition, flea markets, ethnic dances”;

--Class 42: “Legal research; legal services; computer programming for others; computer consultation; computer software consultation; consulting services in the field of design, selection, implementation and use of computer hardware and system software systems for others; maintenance and repair of computer software; rental of computers and computer software; providing search engines and hyperlinks through global computer networks; providing customized online web pages featuring user-defined information, which includes search engines and online web links to other web sites in the fields of international and humanitarian law, medicine, hospital administration and architecture, agricultural method, veterinary care, sanitation methods, development and environment protection; charitable services, namely, providing computer equipment to schools; chemical analysis”;

--Class 43: “Travel agency services, namely, making reservations and booking for temporary lodging; charitable services, namely, providing temporary lodging, furniture and food

to displaced and disaster-stricken populations, and providing food to needy persons; child care; day care center”;

--Class 44: “Medical services; emergency medical assistance, namely, first aid services; medical and surgical services, namely, orthopedic treatments and implantation of prostheses; relief assistance services in the agricultural, veterinary and sanitary fields, namely, rental of agricultural equipment, agricultural advice, spreading of fertilizers and other agricultural chemicals; veterinary vaccines for bovine, sheep and horses; veterinary services; veterinary surgery; medical services in the nature of communicable disease control; medical evaluation services, namely, functional assessment program for patients receiving medical rehabilitation services for purposes of guiding treatment and assessing program effectiveness; health care in the nature of health maintenance organizations; vaccination services; ante natal care, post natal care; communicable disease control; food nutrition consultation; nutrition consulting; medical consultation services, namely, pharmacy consultation to assist patients and consumers; providing medical information activated online via a web site; providing web sites featuring information in the field of medical and veterinary services; charitable services, namely, providing medical services to underdeveloped countries”;

--Class 45: “Missing persons tracing and investigation services; charitable services, namely, providing clothing to

needy persons".

REMARKS

Applicant has amended its identification of goods and services in response to the issues raised by the Examining Attorney in her Office Action of July 1, 2003. This amendment clarifies the identification of goods and services to reflect the true nature and character of the goods and services provided in connection with the ICRC mark.


