More than 120 days have expired since the above-referenced application was published and pursuant to TBMP §207.03, and the parties previously entered into stipulated agreements extending the time to file a Notice of Opposition to the above application, up to and including November 23, 2004. The parties have agreed on a proposal, the written embodiment of which the Potential Opposer has already signed, and they have entered into a stipulated agreement that the time to file a Notice of Opposition to the above application should be extended sixty (60) days, up to and including **January 22, 2005** while the agreement is executed by the Applicant. As required in the Board's order of November 13, 2003, the parties state that the Potential Opposer signed the final, agreed-upon written settlement agreement on September 21,


2004 and sent execution copies to the Applicant's counsel on October 12, 2004, and that the parties merely need additional time for the Applicant to execute the agreement.


