AMENDMENT

Please delete the current description of services in Class 41 listed in this application and substitute the following:

Synthesizing sound of human voice for others, creation of music for others, providing information on-line from a computer database or a global computer network relating to entertainment, education, or music, entertainment services, namely, providing online computer games, providing on-line non-downloadable electronic publications, publication of electronic books and journals on-line, providing non-downloadable digital music from a global computer network, presentation of live performances by a musical band, providing temporary use of on-line non-downloadable computer software in the field of music, in International Class 41;

The description of goods and services in Classes 9, 15, and 42 remain unchanged.

REMARKS

The Examining Attorney states that the wording "sound generation" is too broad because it could include services classified in other classes and requires that the wording "music creation services by commission" be amended to read with greater specificity. As required, Applicant has amended this wording to specify that the sound generation services are synthesizing the sound of human voices and that the music creation services are for others. Applicant has amended the description of goods and services in accordance with the Examining Attorney's requirements and submits that it is sufficient for purposes of registration.

Applicant believes it has sufficiently addressed the issues raised in the Office Action and respectfully requests that the application be approved for publication.
