
In response to the Office Action dated November 9, 2005, Applicant hereby responds as follows:

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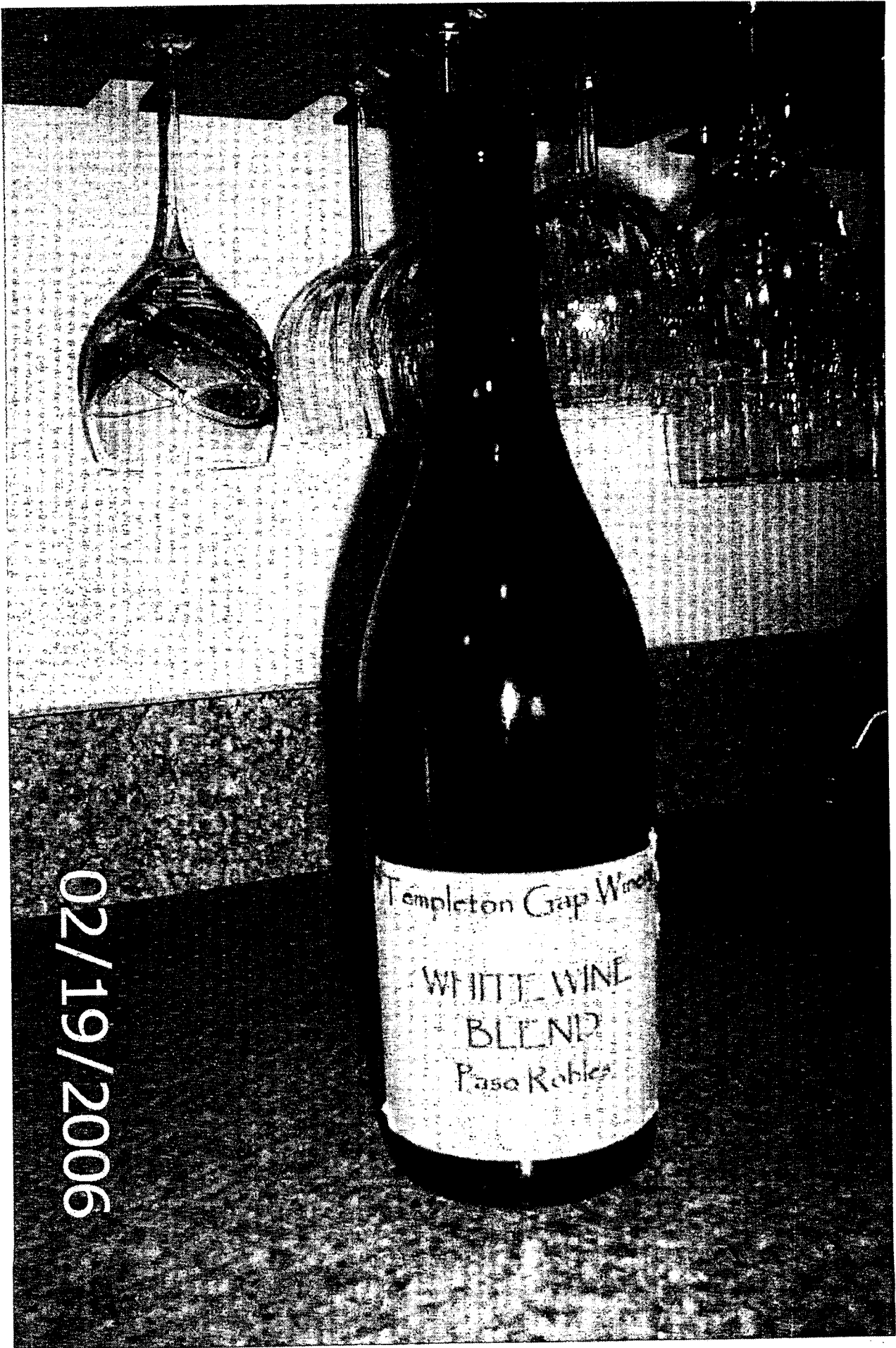
