By the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board:

The Board notes that the notice of appeal in this application was filed by Eric Adler of Adler Vermillion & Skocilich, LLP. However, Office records show that applicant is represented by Angela M. Bozzuti of Davis & Gilbert LLP. We have no record of a revocation of that representation. Although the Board will accept a notice of appeal that is signed by an attorney even if he or she is not the attorney of record, the Board will continue to correspond only with the attorney of record. TBMP Section 1202.03.¹

Accordingly, if applicant wishes to have the Adler Vermillion & Skocilich firm represent it, it should file a revocation and new power attorney appointing them to do so.

¹ Please note that the Trademark Examining Operation will not accept any document that is signed by an attorney that is different from the attorney that has been appointed to act for the applicant and the power has not been revoked.

The power should be signed by applicant itself. A new qualified practitioner cannot sign a revocation of the previous power. See TMEP Section 606. Applicant is allowed thirty days (30) days to file such a document, failing which correspondence will continue to be sent to the Davis & Gilbert firm. Proceedings in the appeal are otherwise suspended.

A courtesy copy of this order is being sent to the Adler law firm, but in the future the Board will not engage in duplicate correspondence.
