CONSENTED EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE OPPOSITION

Dear Sir or Madam:

Under the provisions of TBMP Rule 2.102 et seq., Harman International Industries, Incorporated, a Delaware corporation, having its principal place of business at 8500 Balboa Boulevard, Northridge, California 91329, requests that the time period for filing a notice of

opposition to prevent registration of the above-identified mark be extended for a period of 30 days or until September 14, 2003.

Potential opposer is aware that July 16, 2003 marked the 120 day maximum deadline for filing a Petition to Oppose. Potential opposer contacted Applicant's attorney, Mr. David Kelly, and obtained Applicant's consent to a 30 day extension via e-mail response. Said Consented Extension of Time to File Opposition was filed timely by potential opposer.

This is potential opposer's second consented extension of time to file opposition. On August 12, 2003, Mr. Kelly consented to a second extension. Under TBMP Rule 2.102(c)(2), a request for extension beyond the 120 day deadline is acceptable through a "written request by the potential opposer or its authorized representative stating that the applicant or its authorized representative has consented to the request, and including proof of service on the applicant or its authorized representative". Potential opposer is complying with this Rule.

Potential opposer requests acceptance of this extension, which is made for good cause to continue communication with the Applicant's representative in an effort to resolve the matter prior to filing a formal opposition.

This request is filed in triplicate pursuant to Rule 2.102(d), along with service on Applicant and Applicant's authorized representative.
