FSL is an exclusive licensee of International Market Place, Inc. (hereafter IMI) under U. S. trademark registrations 1,701,041, 1,702,336 and 1,710,606 covering the mark FISHBONE and variations thereof. IMI has also been granted a sixty-day time extension in which to oppose this published application. IMI is presently engaged in direct settlement talks with the corporate parent of the Applicant. IMI counsel has informed FSL that the said corporate parent will be presenting a settlement proposal to IMI and FSL later this month, that settlement negotiations are likely to continue and intensify after receipt of the offer, and that such negotiations may lead to a settlement.

FSL requests this time extension to allow time to determine whether the described settlement negotiations can eliminate the need for a formal opposition by FSL.


