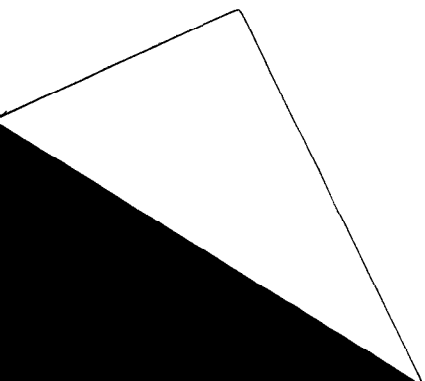

Good cause exists to grant the requested extension, in that this time is needed in order for Pfizer Health Solutions Inc. and its counsel to investigate




